NIC Outreach 2024

Nicholson is focusing on outreach to schools, especially to preschools in order to promote 1000 Books before Kindergarten. NIC already has PuRL reserved for several community events and is cultivating a relationship with the Jackson County Health Dept.

Regular outreach visits:

- Rhonda and Jill began regular monthly visits to South Jackson Elementary School in the 2024-2025 school year. Teachers sign up their classes to take turns checking out from PuRL. Dates are Aug 19, 2024, Sep 9, 2024, Oct 28, 2024, Nov 18, 2024, Dec 16, 2024, Jan 27, 2025, Feb 24, 2025, Mar 17, 2025, Apr 21, 2025, and May 5, 2025.
 - a. We use these visits to promote PLAY cards and to spread awareness of library events and services for struggling students, like GLS.
