-The new system for downloading PicoSoft is ridiculous. Sorry. Here is the process...

Note: this appears to not work with IE11, despite the site's suggestion to add it to compatibility view. You'll need to use a different browser.


Step #1: Visit this site:

Step #2: Become a member

Find the **Become a member** (TOP RIGHT CORNER) link and fill out the form. There is no point in trying to do anything without being logged in.

Step #3: Get back to the site above, but as a logged in member. Then search for **Picosoft** in the "**Product Search:**" box. It should find two hits, PicoSoft and PicoSoft Pro. Select the **non-Pro** version, then select the newest version. At present 6.22 is the newest version.




Step #4: Click on the "Downloads" button




Step #5: Click on either the Show downloads link (as shown below) or the checkbox for Select Files (the checkbox is probably better).




Step #6: Add this file to your Downloads cart by checking the box or clicking on the text (again I'd probably just check the box, but the click here works too)



Step #7: Click on "**Download Cart**" which should now have 1 item in it. Then in the popup click on **Download now**.



Step #8: Agree to the terms then click Direct Download



This should bring up a page to finally let you download the file. The file you get is a .exe, run it to extract the contents to the location of your choice. Extract that .zip which will give you another .zip to extract. **Really?** The .zip just extracted to give me another .zip? **Yes.**

Step #9: Extract the **PicoSoft_V6.22.zip** (this is the file we've always wanted) to wherever you like.

Step #10: Now you should have a setup.exe file. Run it! The rest should be easy and match the video now.

Sorry the process is so much extra trouble now compared to what the video did.
