## Universal Work Habits Expectations for Behavior at MRMS

- Students receive work habits grades every 2 weeks based on observed behaviors aligned to these expectations
- Teachers may determine if one or multiple work habit grades are assessed each cycle aligned to these expectations as they deem appropriate.
- Teachers also determine which of these behaviors are assessed in each 2 week cycle based on the learning activities that best align with these expectations.
