Makeup Description

Clean girl, East Coast makeup. Sunkissed blush. Blush and contour both with the goal of softening the face and making a rounder look (tutorials below). Light pink or gold eyeshadow look with eyeliner and mascara (tutorial below). No highlighter. Powder required. Foundation and concealer recommended.

Hair Description

Either fully straightened with an inward curve at the bottom, or curled into a rich, wavy style. Inspiration photos below, we will try both.

Products Needed

Foundation (Recommended)

Concealer (Recommended)

Powder (Required)

Contour/Bronzer (either or, I personally use bronzer as contour, either liquid or powder is fine)

Blush (powder or liquid, either is fine)

Light pink/coral lipstick (Can be either glossy or matte, and whichever light shade you have, needs to be somewhat subtle)

Mascara/Eyeliner (Eyeliner can be black or brown)

Eyeshadow (a light pink or gold shade, whatever you have)

(Either gel or a brush for eyebrows, make them as rounded and soft as possible)

Different types of blush, “W” type blush for Dakota. (Also add blush minimally to chin and forehead to add to the sunkissed look)
