First Quarter IR: Book 2

This book project is a little different - you'll be completing it in 2 parts.

Part One: Mid-Progress Check. October 17th

By this point, you should be at least halfway through your reading! As you read, think about the different conflicts the characters encounter. You may even want to use post-it notes to mark anything that stands out. You'll complete this "progress check" <u>during class time</u> on October 17th. You'll receive full instructions on that day.

Part Two: Final project. Due October 28th

For the final project, you will make a short slideshow on Google Slides or Prezi.

- Slide 1: Full heading, title of book, author of book, genre
- Slides 2 & 3: Write about 2 connections you can make to this book (think about the 3 types of connections...)
- Slide 4: Who else should read this book and why? (a good paragraph)
- Slide 5: List 3-5 other books that someone would like if they have read & enjoyed this book.
- Slide 6: Credits (if necessary). Credit any images or other outside sources used.

All work for ALL portions of this project should be <u>original!</u> That means you are using your own words, your own thoughts, your own ideas, not copying & pasting someone else's.
