Title I funds will be used to pay the *partial* salary of one Title 1 teacher who will provide supplemental instruction and extended day programming, as well as the family engagement events. Funds are also used to pay highly qualified teachers to provide after school tutoring. The number of staff will be dependent upon the number of Title I students who participate in after school tutoring. Funds are also used to pay for one summer program teacher and one summer program educational technician.

Supplemental Instruction: Our Title 1 teacher will work with students who are not meeting grade level standards. Students eligible for Title I services will be identified using data collected from the NWEA, Aimsweb, and Fountas & Pinnell data. Teacher recommendation will also be considered. Programming and a comprehensive intervention model will include supplemental support services through Reading Recovery, Leveled Literacy intervention, and small group targeted instruction and tutoring in reading, writing, and math. Students who are performing below grade level will receive supplemental support through one-on-one or small group instruction of targeted skills that support classroom curricula. Priority is given to students in grades K-2 for literacy, particularly focusing on Reading Recovery programming for 1st grade students.

Family Engagement: At least two parent events will be held at LCS before June 1, 2023. These events will be coordinated by the Principal and the Title 1 teachers and be implemented with support from classroom teachers and educational technicians. The evening events will be focused on the importance of literacy and math activities in the home. We will provide resources and strategies to use in the home. Books and/or informational literature and resources will be distributed to all families with Title 1A eligible students.

Extended Day: Funds will be used to provide individual/small group tutoring and/or programming before school, after school, and during school vacations. Funds will also be used to provide four weeks of summer programming. We expect to serve between 12-16 Title IA eligible students at LCS, with summer program priority given to incoming Kindergarten students demonstrating a potential delay on the Developmental Indicators for the Assessment of Learning (DIAL) and those students entering first through 4th grade who are not meeting grade level benchmarks according to either the NWEA MAP or Fountas and Pinnell. Programming will include supplemental support through one-on-one or small group instruction of targeted skills that support classroom curricula
