Why Install a Plugin?

Zotero is a powerful tool that can help you with your research. What you download and install on your computer is the "core" software.

However, there are a number of "plugins" that allow you to augment the core functionalities of Zotero.




You can find Plugins on the **Zotero plugins page**

For example, do you use Latex? Well, there's a plugin for you. Go ahead and scroll through the different plugins on this page. You may not need any, but if you do, you can install them by first downloading the .xpi file to your computer.




Install from Download

You can install a plugin that you've downloaded by going to Tools \rightarrow Plugins



This will bring up a new menu for "Manage Your Plugins"



Click on the "gear" icon on the right and click "Install Plugin From File"

Navigate to the folder you downloaded the .xpi file to, and double click it.

You may need to agree and restart Zotero.
