We are unable to post overseas.

We try to reuse packaging where possible to help the environment and keep costs down, Many companies send us fragile items like pencils in bubble wrap and polystyrene bits, we're not buying those, just reusing where we can.

If you are not happy with anything you have received we will refund you if goods are returned in resaleable condition within 14 days for the cost of the goods minus the postage we have had to pay. Please pack carefully.
