## 2025 Swine Judges

#### **Travis Platt - Market Barrow**

Travis is from Roanoke Indiana. Alongside his wife Adrienne and three boys they own and operate Platt Showpigs and Upperhand Genetics. They are also co-owners of thepigplanet.com. Travis graduated from Purdue University with a major in animal agribusiness in 2006. Travis actively judges many shows across the U.S. and a fun fact is that the first state fair he ever judged was here in Minnesota!

## **Doug Albright - Breeding and Market Gilt**

Doug Albright is a seasoned livestock professional based in Coldwater, Michigan. A graduate of Black Hawk East and Kansas State University, Doug was a member of the 2008 Reserve National Champion Livestock Judging Team, an achievement that helped launch his respected career in the industry. He operates Albright Swine Farms, a family-run operation managing approximately 250 showpig sows. The farm not only produces top-tier showpigs but also supplies pork to a variety of wholesalers across the region. In addition to his farming operation, Doug serves as a Show Feeds Specialist for Show-Rite, where he supports youth and breeders in their pursuit of success in the show ring. Doug has judged livestock shows in 37 states, bringing a well-rounded and experienced perspective to each event. He and his wife Dana are proud parents to their two children: 7-year-old Kaiser and 3-year-old Nora.

## Jenna Siegel Meteer - Market Barrow Showmanship

Originally from Marion, Ohio, Jenna Siegel-Meteer was raised on her family's 80-sow showpig operation, Isla Grande Farms, which earned national recognition for its success in the showpig industry. She was actively involved in the operation and gained early experience in competitive livestock production. Jenna continued her education and livestock judging career at Lincoln Land Community College and Iowa State University, where she was a member of both highly regarded livestock judging teams. Since then, she has judged livestock shows in more than a dozen states, including state fairs and national-level competitions. She now resides in Bement, Illinois, where she works as a Swine Credit Officer for Compeer Financial. Jenna and her husband, Chance, are raising their young daughter, Lainey, and currently run a seedstock Hereford operation, with future plans to expand into sow herd production.

## Walker McDermott - Breeding and Market Gilt Showmanship

Walker McDermott is from Wiota, Iowa. He grew up exhibiting cattle, sheep, and pigs at the state and national level. Walker is a graduate of Iowa State University with a double bachelors in Agricultural Studies and Agronomy, and a Masters in education from Colorado State University.

Currently he is a co-owner of Refresh Livestock with sister and brother in law where they focus on raising competitive show heifers among various breeds. Walker is the owner of WM Media and can often be found traveling the country taking sale photos of cattle, sheep, goats, and pigs. Walker says he has been blessed to sort shows and work with so many youth across the country. In his free time, he enjoys getting to work with customers and their livestock and sharing knowledge with the next generation of show livestock enthusiasts.

## **Bonus trip winners**

The following counties have received a Bonus State Fair trip for their Programming Excellence. Congratulations to all!!

#### **Dakota**

In May, a hands-on workshop titled "All Things Swine" was held to educate 4-H members on various aspects of the swine industry. Facilitators included Bailey Ruen from MN Pork, Ben Markegard and Bret Otte from River Country Co-op/ShowRite, and Lindsey Loken from Blondie's Butcher Shop. Bailey kicked off the event with an overview of MN Pork, career opportunities in the industry, and a fun swine trivia

session. Ben followed with practical tips on pig care, including skin and hair maintenance, stress reduction, and illness identification. He and Bret also demonstrated how to read medication labels and administer treatments safely. Lindsey wrapped up the workshop with a pork cutting demonstration, highlighting food safety while preparing pork chops and tenderloins. To finish the evening, participants cooked their own pork chop dinners, making it a fun and educational event. Congratulations Dakota County!

#### Jackson

In May, Jackson County's animal science meeting brought together 47 participants to explore key youth development opportunities in Jackson County and Minnesota 4-H, focusing on Skill-a-thon, Project Bowl, and Livestock Demonstrations. The event began with a review of livestock demonstration guidelines and ways to boost youth confidence, using swine-related topics as accessible examples. Attendees then discussed the Project Bowl, sharing tips for team preparation and coaching before forming small groups to practice sample questions. The Skill-a-thon segment highlighted hands-on learning through animal identification, equipment recognition, and industry-based questions, all aimed at developing critical thinking and teamwork. The meeting emphasized how these activities not only build animal science knowledge but also extend beyond swine, offering youth a broader understanding of the livestock industry. Congratulations Jackson County!

## **Murray**

Murray County 4-H launched a new educational event called "Livestock 101" in April, aimed at introducing both current and prospective 4-H families to the basics of livestock care. Held at the Murray County 4-H Building, the free workshop was led by 4-H staff, youth members, and volunteers. The event highlighted what is required to care for various livestock species and the equipment needed, providing a welcoming and informative experience for new families. Thirty-two youth and ten adult volunteers participated, showcasing the strong community support and the value of 4-H livestock projects. Congratulations Murray County!

#### **Nobles**

A swine necropsy lab was held at the Nobles County Fairgrounds, led by Dr. Andrew Bents in partnership with Hubbard Feeds and the University of Minnesota, to educate 4-H youth on pig anatomy and common swine diseases. The lab followed a Certified Swine Sample Collector training offered to area pork producers, and was open to all interested 4-H'ers in Nobles County. Nine youth and five parents attended, examining the organs of a 200-pound pig and learning how diseases affect swine health, prevention methods, and treatment options. The hands-on experience sparked thoughtful questions and discussion, with one parent from a local packing plant offering additional insights, enriching the learning opportunity for all. Congratulations Nobles County!

#### Rice

The Rice County Swine PDC hosted a workshop titled "Getting Your Pig Ready for the Show Ring" in the Swine Barn show arena, focusing on nutrition, feed rations, skin and hair care, equipment, pig handling tips, and showring skills. The event drew six 4-Hers and four parents, with additional engagement before and after the session. This workshop built on pre-COVID outreach efforts and has contributed to a significant

increase in swine project participation, nearly doubling the number of pigs exhibited. It also strengthened communication between youth and Swine PDC leaders, fostering a supportive and educational environment that continues to grow. Congratulations Rice County!

#### **Stearns**

This year marks significant growth for the Stearns County 4-H Swine Project, driven by focused education efforts including workshops, mentorships, and participation in livestock project bowls. Senior members actively mentor younger youth, while families collaborate to support newcomers with pig purchasing, nutrition, and housing. A highlight was a statewide training workshop held in April, in partnership with MN Purebred Livestock Breeders, which attracted around 150 attendees and energized new swine enthusiasts. Partnering with the MN Pork Board over the past two years, the Stearns swine project has nearly doubled in size and is gaining recognition for both the quality of its animals and the dedication of its youth, making a strong impact in a county traditionally known for dairy. Congratulations Stearns County!

## Washington

On April 23, 2025, Washington County hosted a 4-H Livestock Clinic at the University of Minnesota Meat Lab in St. Paul, welcoming two dozen 4-H youth and adults from Washington and Dakota counties. Led by Meat Lab supervisor Jordan McCallum, the event focused on quality meat production, carcass evaluation, and careers in meat science and butchering. Participants gained hands-on experience evaluating swine and beef carcasses, learned about ethical livestock harvest, and explored meat by-products and grading data. This clinic kicked off the livestock project season by providing valuable education, fostering mentorship, and encouraging collaboration among youth and livestock enthusiasts across both counties. Congratulations Washington County!
