A. Motion (Simpson, Gibson)

That "AA" basketball and volleyball playoffs go to a 2-day format:

B. Motion (Simpson, Gibson)

Change By-Law 8.2.0: After the fourth year of high school, a student must be taking four (4) non-semestered full-time credit courses over the school year or two (2) full credit courses per semester. In "AA" schools, students must be enrolled in three courses in order to participate.

To read: Students who have achieved twenty-two (22) credits must be taking four (4) non-semestered full day school credit courses over the school year or two (2) full day school credit courses in the semester in which he/she participates. Note: This is from OFSAA By-Law 5-4 (c) (ii)

C. Motion (Simpson, Gibson)

Whereas

Change By-Law 8.2.0: After the fourth year of high school, a student must be taking four (4) non-semestered full-time credit courses over the school year or two (2) full credit courses per semester.

D. Motion (Fenelon, Pais)

Whereas

Currently the Norwossa A Girls Hockey division consisting of Saint Thomas Aquinas, Queen Elizabeth and Red Lake High Schools and the Norwossa AA Girls division consisting of Beaver Brae, Dryden and Fort Frances High Schools play the regular season as two different league's up until a winner has been decided in the A playoff. The A winner then joins the AA playoffs. The A winner always joins the AA playoffs as a fourth place team and gives up home ice to the AA teams.

And whereas

Both the A and AA teams from Norwossa meet and play in tournaments throughout the year and the skill level between the A and AA teams have become closer in the last year.

Be it Resolved That

That the two divisions play as one league throughout the regular season and not just in the playoffs. This way all teams have the same advantage and put their own fates in their hands. All teams will have the same chance in their placement before the playoff rounds begin and no team would have an advantage over the other.
