The purpose of report cards is to share with you how your child is doing based on grade level standards. The scale is:

We know your child may not be meeting grade level standards because of their disability. Therefore, spend more time looking at this Progress Report that outlines progress based on IEP Goals. The progress report is aligned to your child's day to day classroom learning.

It is important to encourage your child by celebrating one area of strength from the reporting process and making a goal together for continued improvement. This supports the growth mindset, which is a belief that success is based on hard work, learning, and perseverance.
