The planned panel discussions are as follows (subject to change):

(Medical Use of Cannabis and Use Offenses)

While clinical trials have begun for the cannabis-derived medicine Epidiolex, aimed at treating refractory pediatric epilepsy, new offenses are being created for the use of cannabis for recreational purposes. We will discuss the changes brought about by the revisions and the future prospects and challenges with experts, including Member of the Diet Akino Kozo, who has played a central role in the revision of the control law.

[Questions about the Pharmaceutical Affairs Law]

The Pharmaceutical Affairs Law is about the manufacturing and selling of pharmaceuticals, and it sets the rules for what can and cannot be claimed in product advertising and marketing. Current CBD products on the market are also subject to this law, and understanding it is essential for CBD product sellers. We will have experts in the Pharmaceutical Affairs Law to explain it in detail.

[Position and Method of Testing Institutions]

CBD products currently distributed in Japan are positioned as health supplements, and strict quality testing is not mandatory. However, as the market expands and the variety of products increases, testing institutions to ensure product safety will become crucial. Experts will explain what is required of testing institutions and what can be learned from various tests.

[Alternative Medicine/Complementary Medicine and Medical Cannabis: The Possibility of Using the Whole Cannabis Plant as Herbal Medicine]

"Medical cannabis" used for various diseases in countries like the U.S. is mostly non-prescription "folk medicine." This can be likened to the position of traditional Chinese medicine in Japan. We will explore the possibility of using the entire cannabis plant for medical purposes in Japan with experts in basic research, traditional Chinese medicine, herbal research, and Western medicine.

[Patient's Voice]

PCAT, supervised by Green Zone Japan, is used by patients who need medical cannabis, not just for epilepsy. We will hear from patients about their experiences and discuss the possibilities and challenges of cannabinoid products that are not pharmaceuticals.

[Industrial Hemp: Initiatives in Mie Prefecture]

In Meiwa Town, Mie Prefecture, the "Tensu Sedge Hemp Project" was launched this year, aiming to inherit the historical and cultural significance of hemp and establish hemp farming as an industry. We will hear from those involved in this visionary project and consider the potential of Japan's hemp industry after the amendment of the Cannabis Control Law.

[Documentary Film "The Scientist" Screening]

This documentary is about Dr. Raphael Mechoulam, known as the "father of cannabinoid research," who passed away in March. To commemorate the publication of his last work, "The Science of CBD," we will trace Dr. Mechoulam's contributions to cannabinoid research.

▶ About the Cannabis Control Act

Enacted shortly after the end of World War II in 1948, under the directives of the GHQ, this law prohibits the cultivation, possession, and distribution of cannabis, excluding matured stems and seeds. Medical use is also not permitted. In January 2021, the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare embarked on a review of the Cannabis Control Act for the first time in 73 years. Following expert committee recommendations, a Cannabis Regulation Subcommittee was established in March 2022. It is anticipated that revisions will be discussed in the regular session of the National Diet in 2023.
