- Identify possible youth/target group for Micro-Enterprises and Vocational Training.
- Facilitate schools strengthening schools system for the regularity and retention of children.
- Facilitate for enrolment campaigns to enroll drop out school age children.
- Facilitate entrepreneurs in making their business plan and provide mentoring counseling support.
- Ensure GESI while implementing project activities in the field.
- Ensure the participation of disabled children, youths and people in the programme activities.
- Facilitate community people to utilize local resources properly.
- Lead child right and youth right promotion activities in the field.
- Follow up bursary supported students and provide counseling regularly.
- Selection of extra-poor families for support and do regular support as per need.

- Ensure proper documentation and record keeping of activities conducted in the field and also update total reach on time.
- Report to your line manager if any unexpected issues arise in communities.
