 - Most recent property tax payment for first half of 2022 was \$60,579.66
 - Cafe revenue split:
 - PPAC \$4600 spent on water heater, electrical work
 - so far ~ \$1800 revenue from 8 weeks open
 - What does this mean?
 - Unclear. We're probably OK through the end of the year until our next tax bill comes through, but realistically the purpose of these cap.


