Dear P.S. 152 Families,

Please allow me to welcome you to the start of the 2025-2026 school year! We are excited to welcome back all of our students. The first day of school will take place on <u>Thursday, September 4th for all students.</u> Safety and learning will continue to be our number one priority.

We are looking forward to a productive partnership with you to ensure our students can reach their highest potential. We recognize that the home-school connection is critical to our students' success in school. We ask that you guide and support your child's learning by ensuring the following:

- Attend school daily and arrive on time for school each morning. School begins promptly at 8:00 AM and ends at 2:20 PM. To promote safety, students will be dismissed according to a staggered schedule. (See Below)
- Please be prompt when dropping off and picking up your child(ren). The students will not be allowed in the building before 7:59 AM and must be picked up **promptly** at 2:20 PM.
- Inform the school if you feel your child needs more support in any subject area.
- Have your child read daily to develop a love of reading and to improve reading stamina and literacy skills critical to successful reading.
- Please accept email invitations from your child's teacher and Ms. Zaccheo for Class Dojo, Google Classroom, and Remind. These platforms will be utilized as a means of communication.
- You will be receiving a schedule of your child's school day from your child's teacher. You will also be
 receiving a Parent Handbook outlining school policy and procedures via Class Dojo and on our
 school's website.
- School has purchased the majority of the supplies that your child will need this year. Your child's teacher will communicate any additional items needed during the first week of school.
- Supply lists for Pre-K students were sent home via mail.
- If your child is feeling sick, please keep your child home from school.
- Breakfast will continue to be Grab & Go and will be eaten in the classrooms.
- Parents will have the opportunity to meet with teachers during **Parent Teacher Conferences on Thursday, September 17, 2025**(this will be a remote conference).

In order to facilitate a smooth opening for the first day of school, the following procedures will be put in place:

Daily Arrival Procedures for Students

The school day begins at 8:00 AM each day. No child will be admitted into the building before 7:59 A.M.

There is no early drop off.

- Designated staff will be available to assist during arrival for all students in our Courtyard, which is located on East 23rd St between Campus Road and Glenwood Road.
- During the first week of school, students will be escorted to their designated class line-up spot in the Courtyard in order to meet their teacher. Classroom teachers in **grades 1-5** will be in the Courtyard at 8:00 AM holding up their class signs.
- **Pre-K, Kindergarten, Class 1-108, and Class 2-**224 students will enter the Courtyard and be escorted into the Gym by school staff. For the safety of all students, parents/guardians are not permitted to escort their child(ren) into the gym.

Daily Dismissal Procedures for Students

All students must be picked up by 2:20PM daily.

Students will be dismissed at the following times:

• Pre-K and Kindergarten: 2:05 PM- Location: Courtyard

• Grades 1 and 2: 2:10 PM - Location: Courtyard

• Grades 3 and 4: 2:15 PM -Location: Courtyard

• Class 3-231 and 5th Grade: 2:15 PM- Location: outside Main Entrance
