ARTICLE: MOVING AND RELOCATION EXPENSES

- The university must provide a one-time "moving expenses" payment to alleviate
 the economic burden of moving to Syracuse. Traveling to Syracuse during peak
 travel season (July-August) can get very expensive, whether it be domestic or
 international travel. Moving costs include but are not limited to plane tickets, gas
 money, security deposits.
- 2. For domestic students, the amount of such payment must be no less than \$2000 to cover at least some part of travel and/or the security deposit. For international students, the amount of such payment must be no less than \$3000 to cover at least some part of travel and/or the security deposit.
- 3. It is important to note that some departments have provided such a payment to upcoming graduate students who require financial assistance. SUch a resource should be accessible to all graduate employees. Besides, such a payment is regularly included within non-academic contracts and should be provided to all graduate employees, regardless of their department.
