

## MASTER OF NURSING 2-YEAR PROGRAM SCHEDULE

55 total degree credits: 45 core credits (BNURS) and 10 elective credits.

The program meets in person one day per week, every other Friday, for a total of 5-6 class meetings per quarter. Electives offered by the program may be online or will follow the same Fridays schedule as the BNURS courses.
