## **Grading**

You'll be assigned a short **homework** assignment daily. It should take no more than 10-15 minutes and can be completed during study hall. The expectation is that it is completed before the next ELA class. If it is not completed, it will be a zero for that assignment. It is an expectation that **all work is turned in on time**. In the event that your homework is late, check in with your teacher after/before school.

Every week students will earn a **Hard Work grade**. These grades will all be habits based. For example students may be graded on organized notes, annotations, writing habits, etc.

### **Homework**
