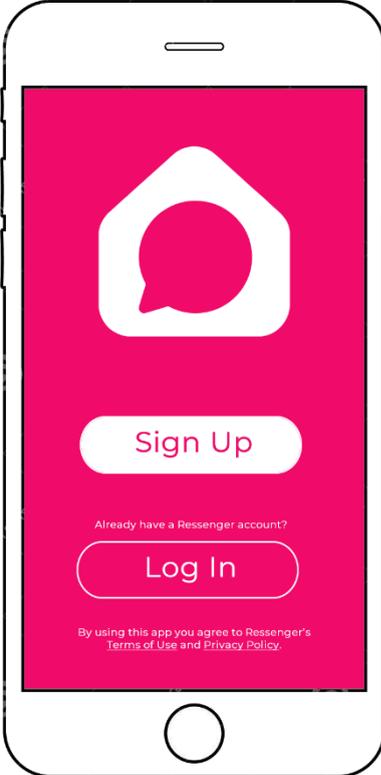
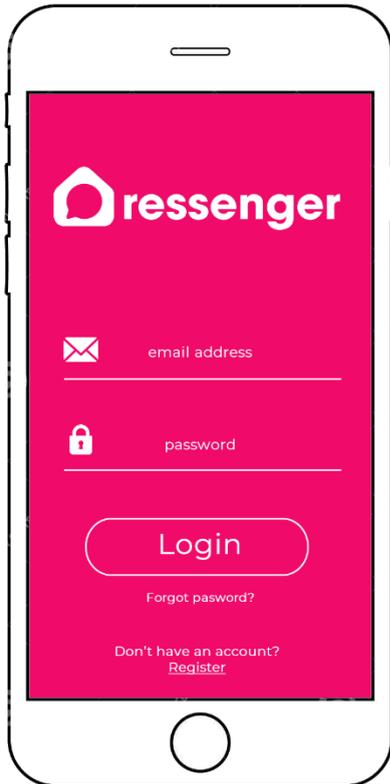
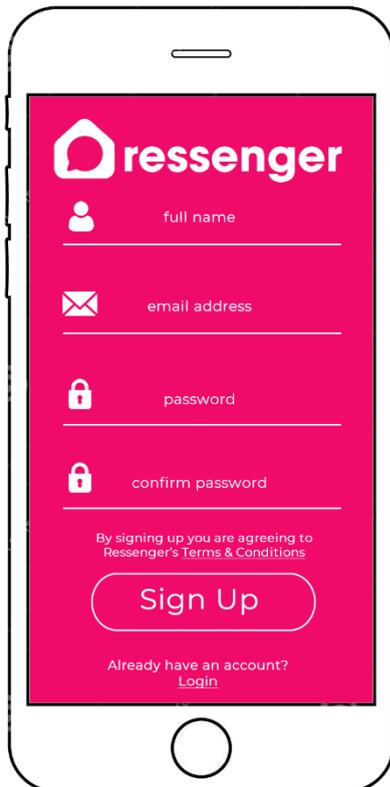


## Ressenger Screens and Features

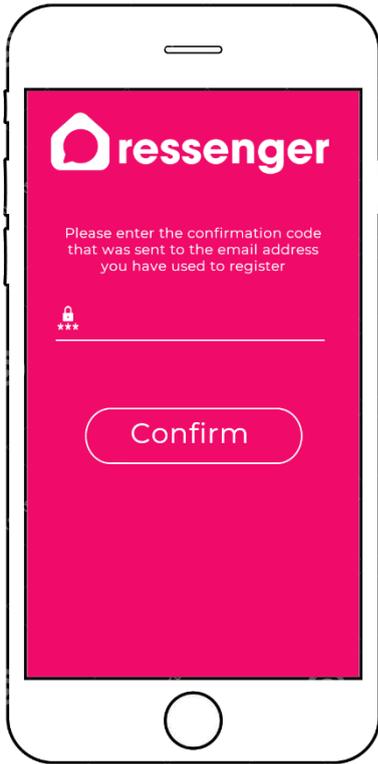

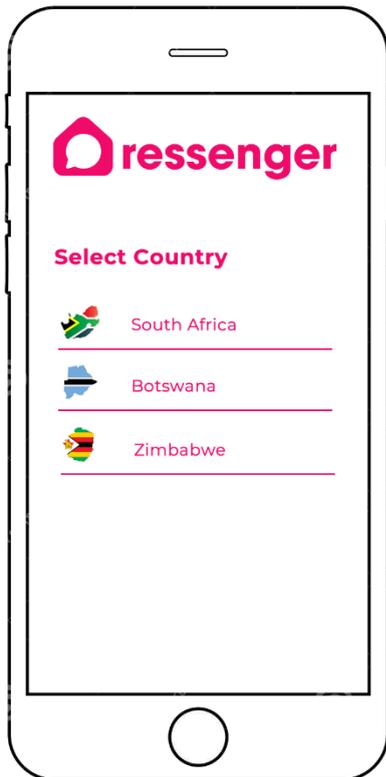
Login screen for users.  
Users login with their email address and password.  
Forgot password link will open a window where they can enter their email address and a reset password link will be emailed to them.  
There is also the option at the bottom to go to the register page.



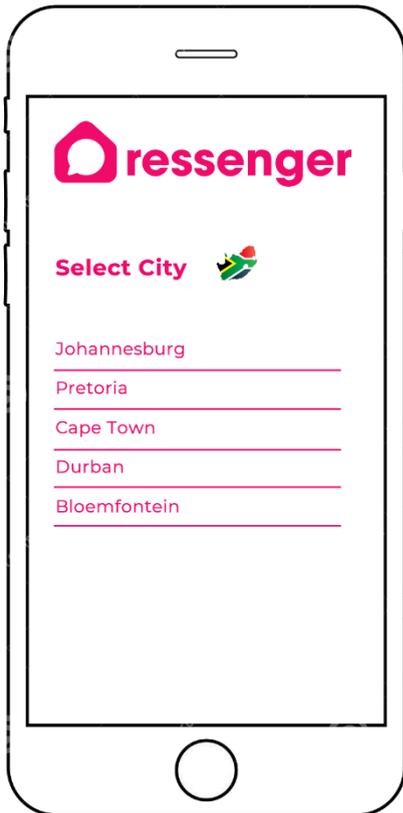
Register page.  
A user registers by entering their full name, email address, password and confirm password. All fields are mandatory.  
There is also a link at the bottom to go to the login page.  
  
Once a user clicks on Sign Up, an email will be sent to their email with a registration code they will need to enter on the next screen to verify their email address.



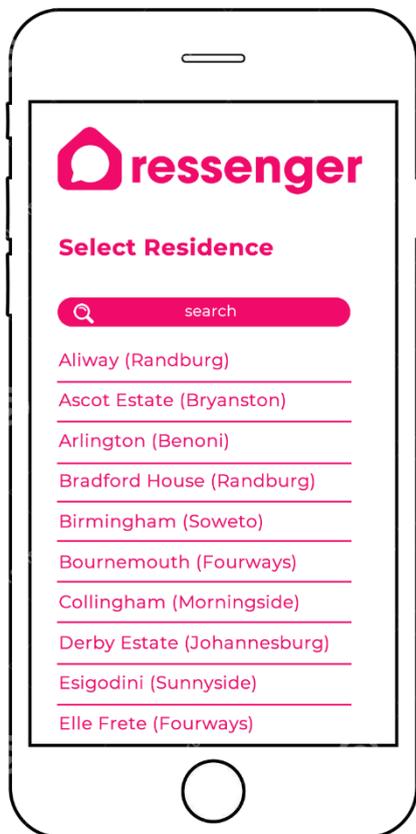
Registration confirmation screen.  
A user will enter the verification code sent to their email in order to verify their email and account.  
Once confirmed the user account will be verified and they go to the next screen to select country.  
If the user enters the wrong code they will be asked to try again.  
There should also be an option to resend code if they did not receive a code.



Select country screen.  
Once user has confirmed their account they will then select the country they are in.  
The list will only display countries that are on the platform.  
Countries will be added in the admin panel with the name of Country and the png image of the country.  
For now we will just have one country – South Africa on the list but we need the provision to be able to add more countries in the admin area.



Select City screen.  
 A user is able to select the city where their apartment block is in that Country. Only cities with listed and active apartment blocks will be displayed. The cities can be added in the admin panel for each country.



Select residence screen.  
 Once a user has selected their city they will then be shown a list of the active residence / apartment blocks in that city. They can then select their residence from the list.

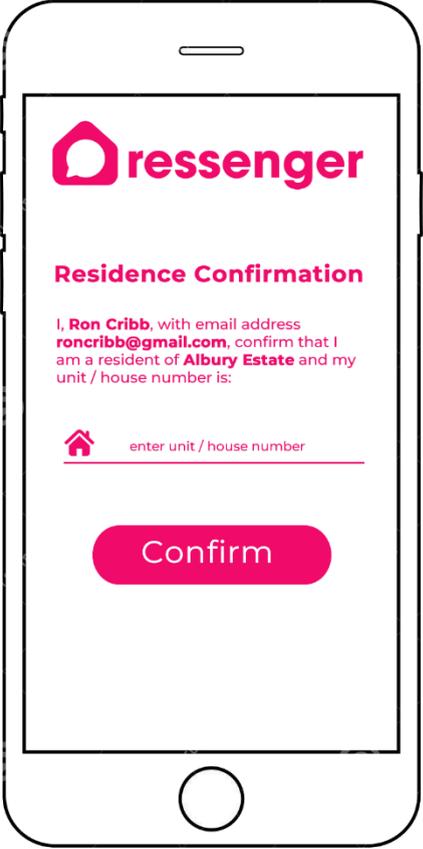
The list may end up being very long as the app grows thus we need a search bar where a user can search for their residence name by typing it in and the search results will be displayed as they type using AJAX.

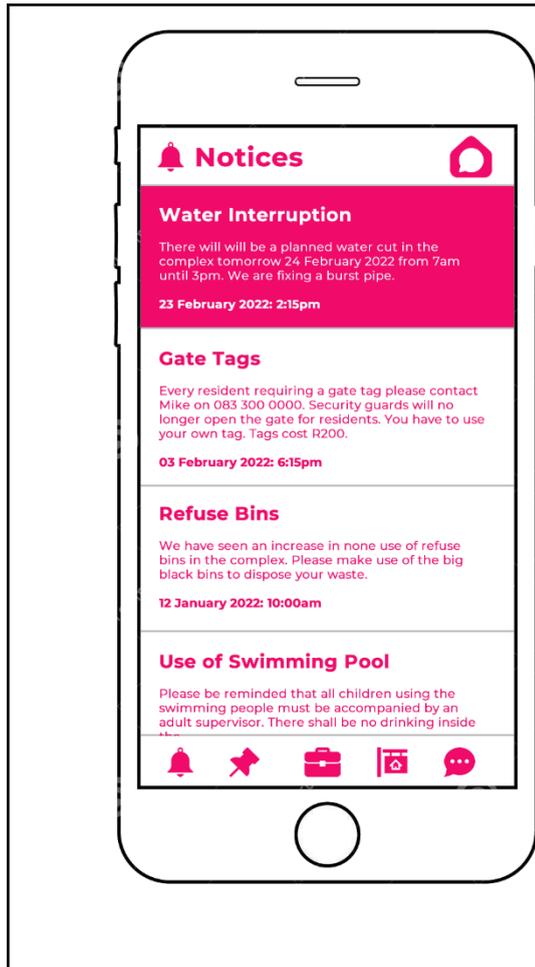
The residences will be added in the admin panel. The name in the brackets next to the residence name is the suburb the residence is in. This will also be added in the admin panel.

Residence settings in admin panel:

So in the admin panel there will be an option to add a residence. To add a residence admin will select / enter:

1. Country of residence
2. City of residence
3. Enter residence name
4. Enter residence suburb
5. Residence admins name

	<p>Residence confirmation screen. Once a user has selected their residence they will then need to confirm the unit / house number of where they reside in that residence. On this screen it will also display the users full name and the residence name in bold as part of the confirmation. The unit / house number is mandatory to enter.</p>

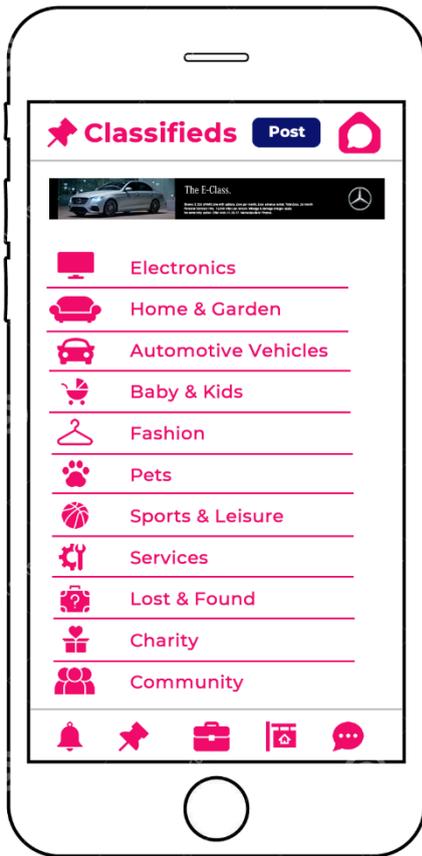


Once registered and / or logged in a user is taken to the Notices screen of the app. This is where notices posted by the residence admin are displayed.

The residence admin is able to log into the Residence admin panel which is web based using an email address and password that will be created by the Ressenger admin.

A residence admin is able to send notices where they are able to enter the notice title and the description of the notice and also attach image(s) to the notice. The notice will be displayed as shown in the screen with the title, description, images and date and time the notice was posted. Latest notices are displayed at the top and unread notices by the user have a pink background and the notices that the user has read are displayed on a white background.

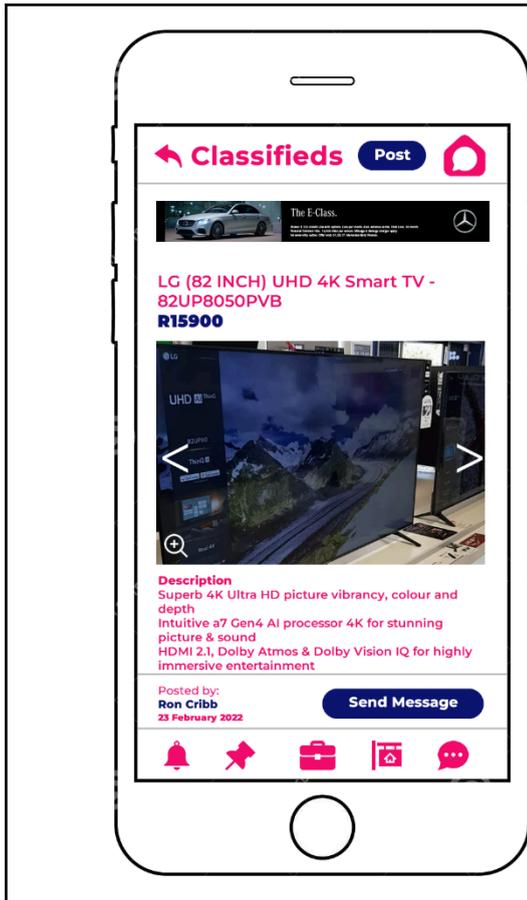
When a notice is posted by the admin the app user will receive a notification that there is a new notice.



Classifieds screen.  
 On this screen a user is able to view the different categories of the classifieds. The categories of the classifieds are the ones displayed on the screenshot. There is also ad space as shown in the screen where a banner ad can be placed. There is also the blue button that will allow a user to post a classified. The messenger icon in the top right is the profile button which will be explained in a separate screen. The bar at the bottom of the screen is a fixed navigation bar throughout the app with the icons representing: Notices, Classifieds, Services, Property, Messages.



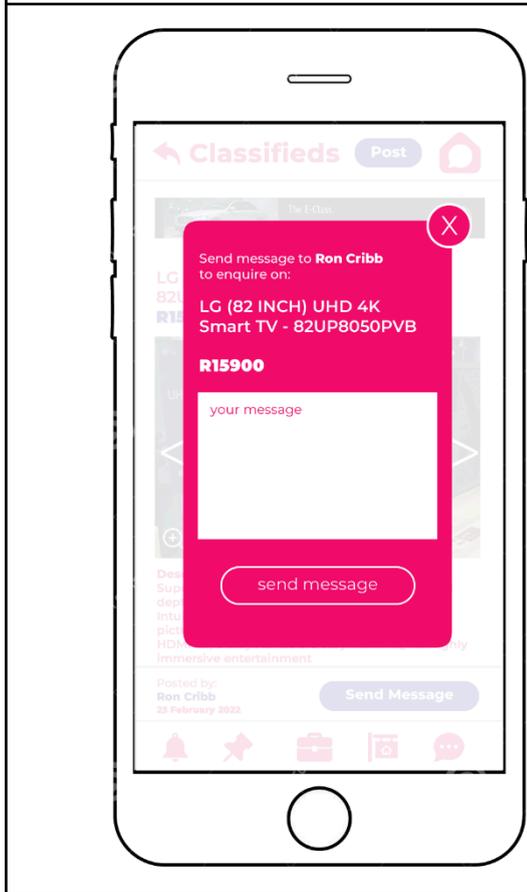
Classified screen.  
 When a user clicks on a category they are taken to a screen that shows the list of the classifieds for that category with the latest posts at the top. There is also space for an ad banner. The back button in the top left will take the user back to the list of classified categories. The list of posts will be shown as in the screenshot with an image of the classified if the user has uploaded one or if no image for the classified it will for the messenger placeholder. The classified will display the post title and an expert of the post description limited to two lines, and also the date of the post. A user then clicks on the post and will be taken to the screen with the full details of the post.  
  
 Posts are displayed for 60 days and will automatically be deleted after then. That is if the user has not deleted the post themselves in their profile.



Detailed Classified post screen.  
 This post displays full details of the classified post namely post title, price, images (we are open to suggestions of how best to display images either as seen in the screen as a slider or as a grid of thumbnails and when a user clicks on a thumbnail the full image pops up as a lightbox), full description.

There is also an ad banner on this page.

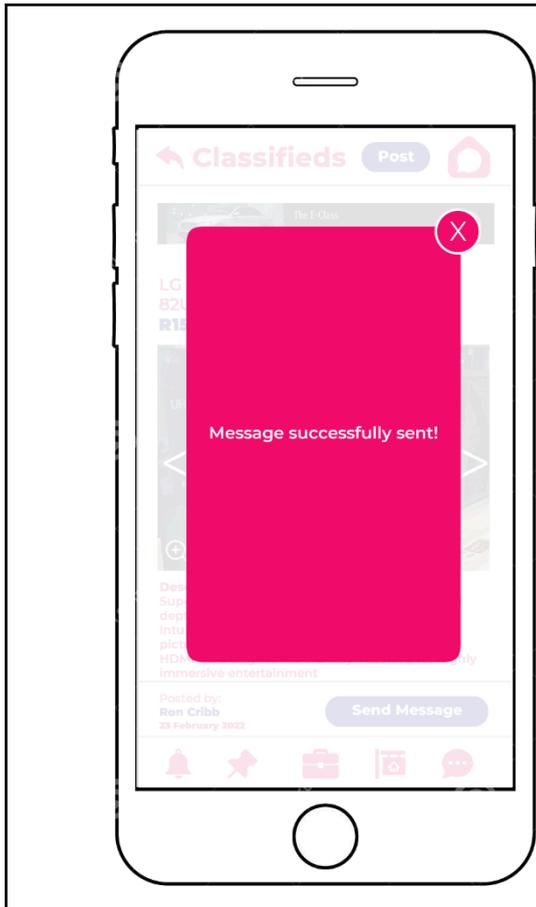
At the bottom of the screen there is a fixed anchor bar which will display the name of the poster, the date it was posted and the send message button which will open a pop up as seen on the next screen that will allow a user to message the poster.



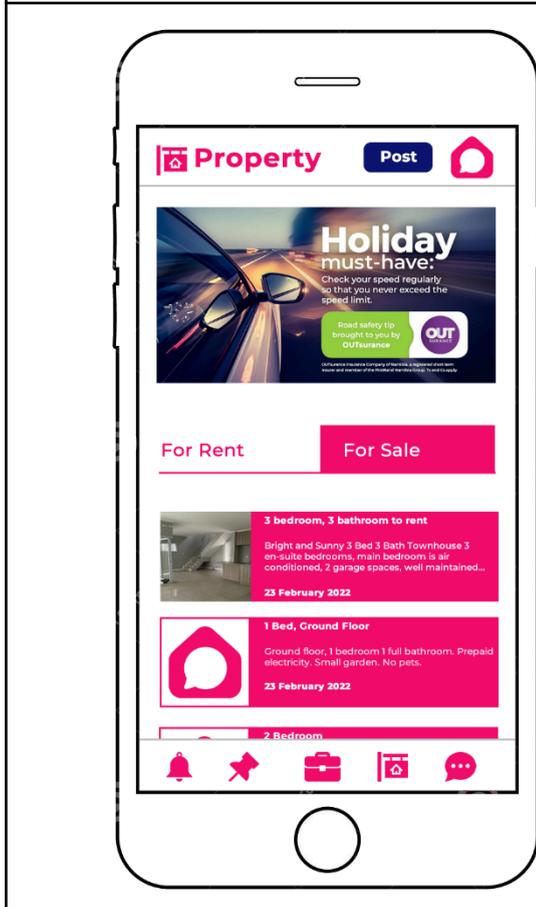
Send message from Classified

When a user clicks on send message in a classified a pop up will appear over a white overlay with details as soon on the screen namely title of classified, price and who you are sending the message to and space to type in a message.

The message will be sent to the user who posted the classified and the message the poster receives will state:  
 "Enquiry for [post title] from [enquirers name] [your message]"

Property Screen.

Similar to Classified listing screen. There is also ad space. In this example I put an ad with a different size to show that we can have ads with different heights in the app.

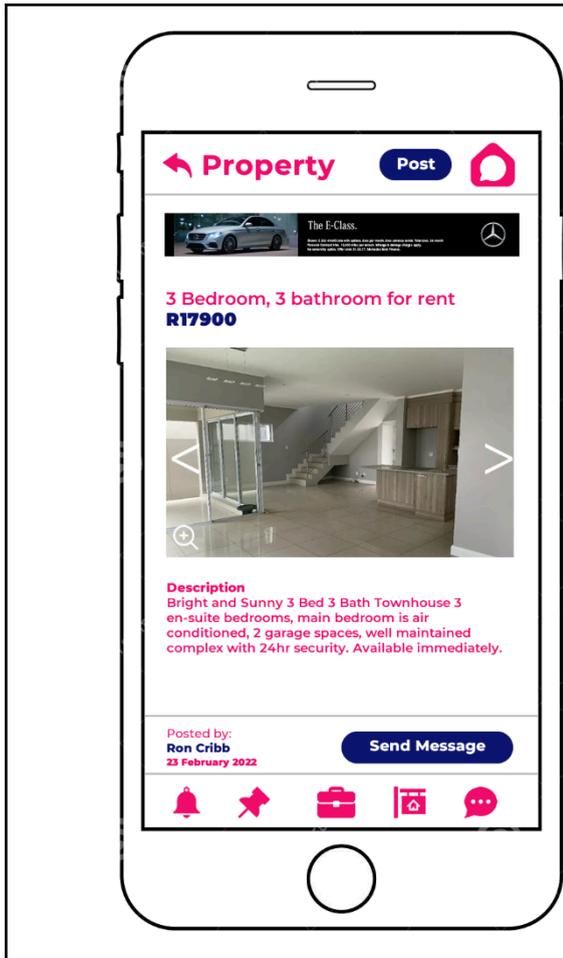
On the property screen the listing are split into two sections: for rent and for sale.

Listings will display post title, expert of description to cover two lines and date of post.

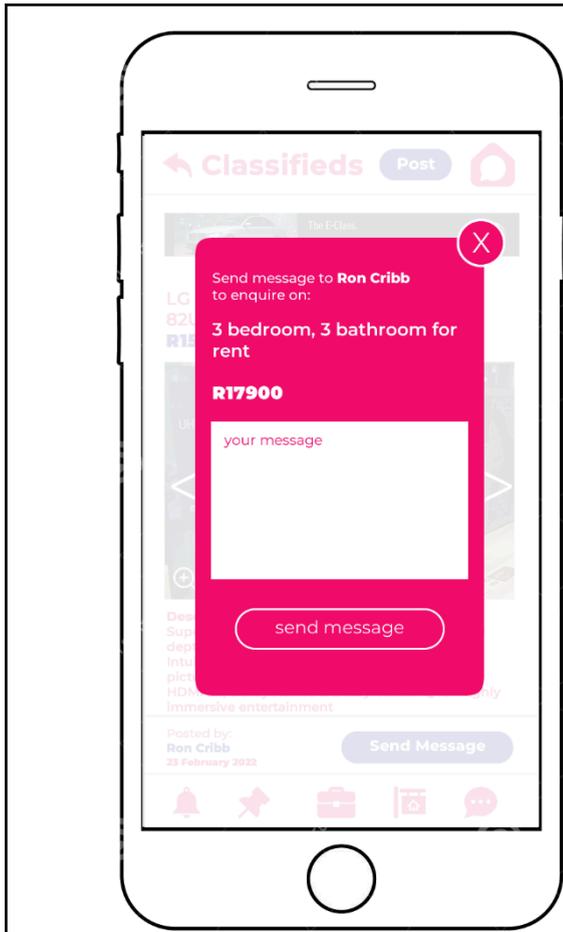
User will click on post to view further details.

Blue post button on top to allow for posting of property posts by user.

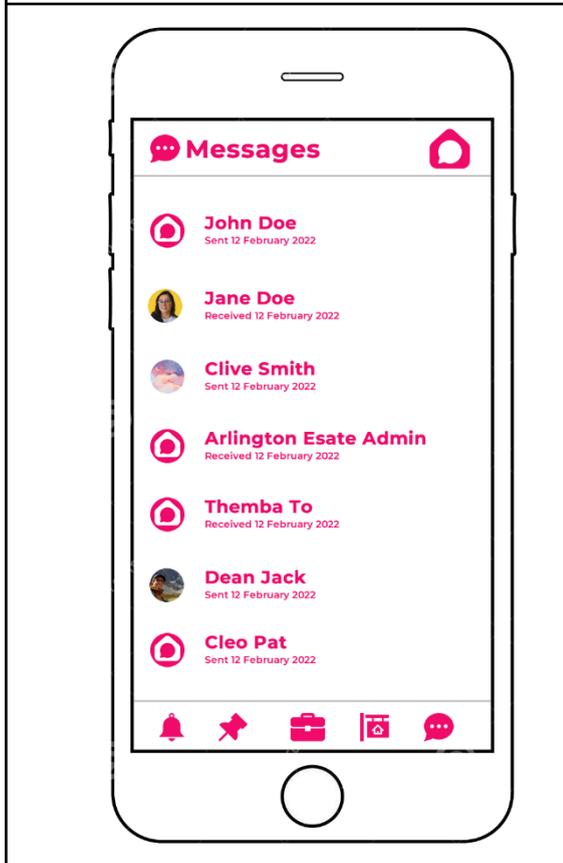

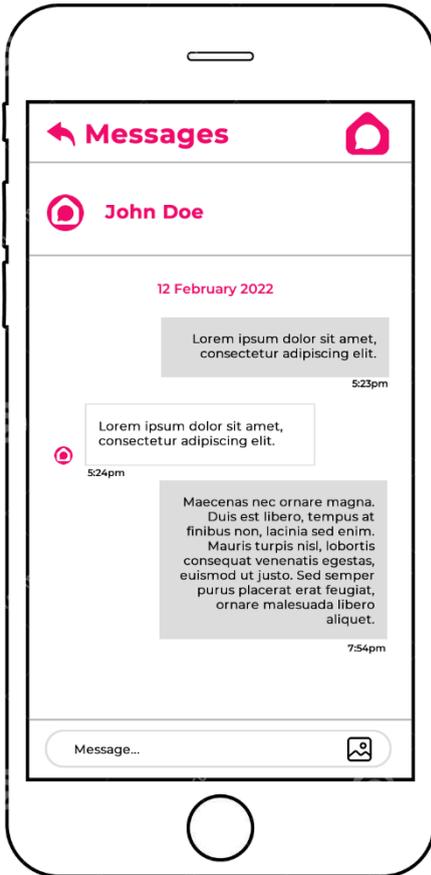

Send message screen for property.

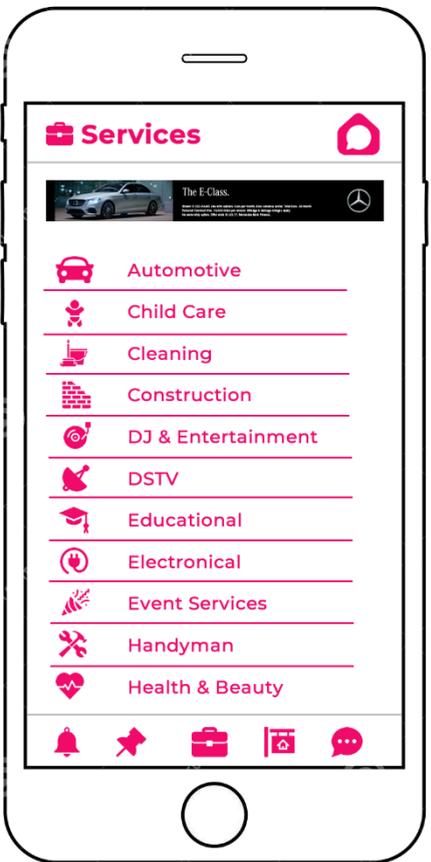


Message screen.  
Very similar to how the messages screen on Instagram is setup.

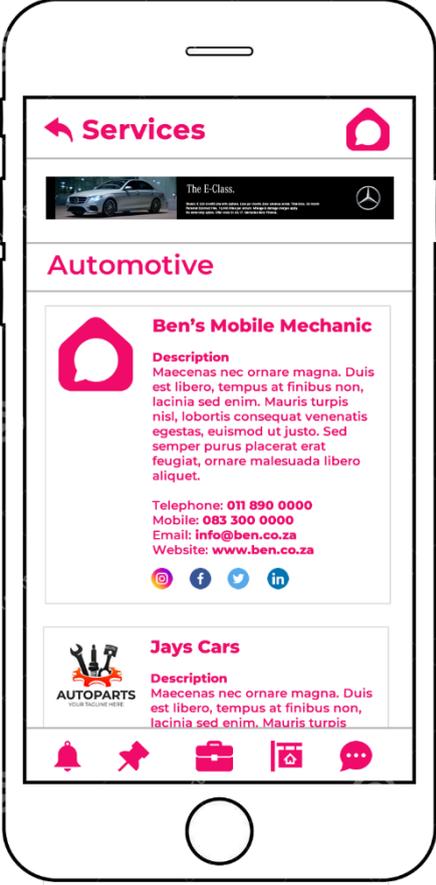


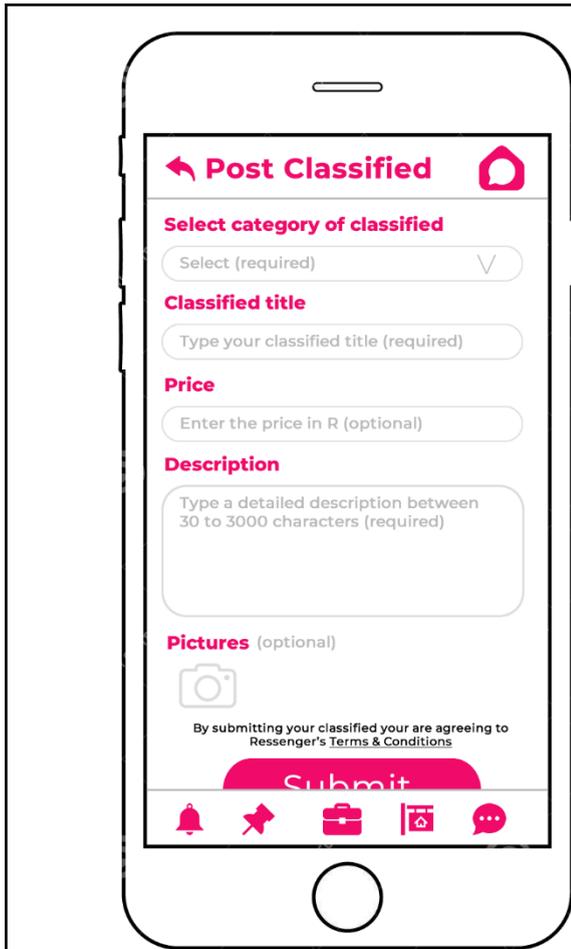
Message detailed screen.

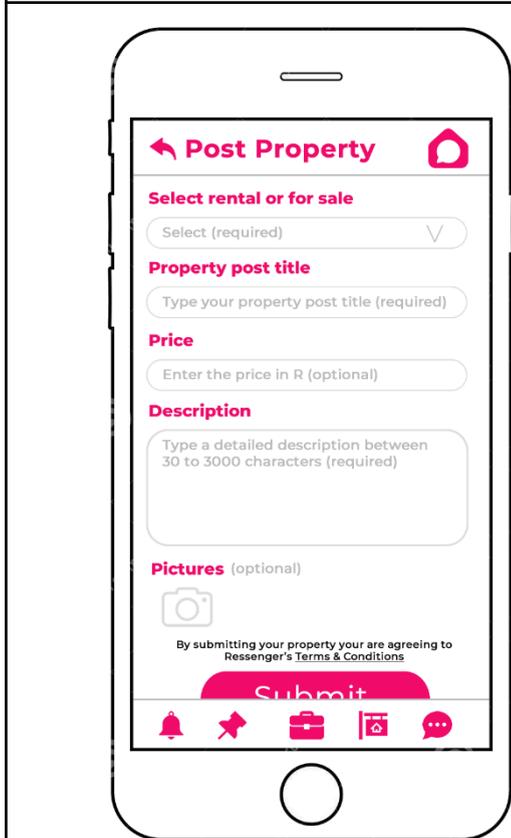

A user can post a classified post and this is the screen they will see.

For pictures they should be able to add a maximum of 10 images.

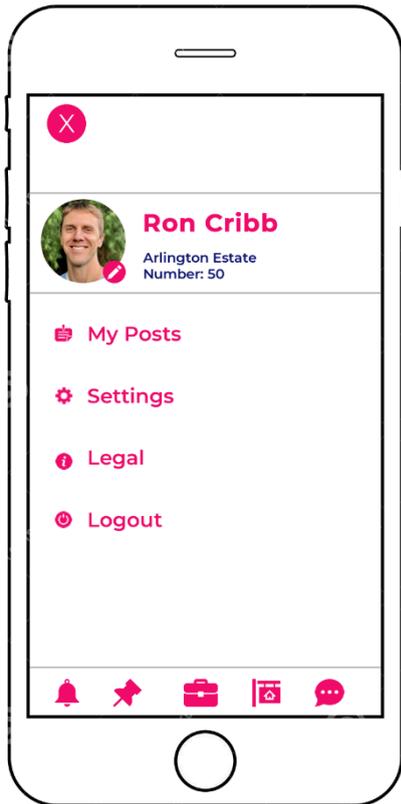


Post classified screen

A user can post a classified post and this is the screen they will see.

They can select if the property is for rental or for sale which is the first option.

For pictures they should be able to add a maximum of 10 images.



### Profile Screen

When a user clicks in the top left corner of the app on the messenger icon they will have access to their profile screen.

The screen will show their name, name of residence and unit number in their residence. It will also show their profile picture which they can edit. Initially the profile picture will be the messenger icon.

The my posts options will take them to a screen where they are able to see all the posts they have posted / published in classifieds and property and they are able to edit and delete those posts.

In Settings they are able to change their email, password and turn on and off notifications. Notifications will be sent when new notices are published and when new messages are received.

In settings there will also be an option to delete account which will allow the user to delete their account and all their data, posts and messages will be deleted from the platform.

Legal will be a screen with the terms and conditions and privacy policy of Messenger.

Logout will allow the user to logout the app.
