Position Summary

We are seeking a Farmer's Market Coordinator to manage the day-to-day operations of the Wolseley Farmers Market (WFM). The coordinator will be responsible, in collaboration with the Market Director, for ensuring that the market runs smoothly each week, and that positive relationships are maintained with vendors, Jonathan's Farm, the Robert A Steen Community Centre, Public Health Inspectors, and the local community. WFM aims to work collaboratively, and so welcomes initiative on behalf of the Market Coordinator to identify and implement additional market-related activities. Any proposed initiatives outside the scope of the activities listed below may be presented to the Market Director for approval.

Position Responsibilities:
