What I Need



Purpose of WIN time:

WIN time is a mini-class period designed to help students balance high school academic life while preparing for post secondary goals. During WIN Time teachers will be assigned to students from each grade level and will remain with those students throughout their HS career. During WIN Time students and teachers will review grades and HS academic progress. Students will have the opportunity to be scheduled with other teachers for enrichment and academic support.

By the end of each trimester, students should be:

- Advocating for individual needs by regularly discussing academic progress with school staff
- Demonstrating motivation and a sense of purpose
- Developing skills and supports for academic and personal success
- Thinking about your future goals and planning how to achieve them

Mona Shores High School Goals

One of our goals is that students will develop a positive supportive relationship with their WIN Time teacher. This teacher will be able to provide support, guidance, encouragement, and direction to be successful while at Mona Shores High School. WIN Time is an opportunity to reflect, grow, set goals and to learn how to utilize strategies to be successful in high school and prepare for success in College, Career and Life.

Why WIN Time?

MSHS cares deeply about the success of all students. Students and teachers are in need of additional time during the day time to maximize the learning experiences for all students. MSHS understands that students are very involved in multiple activities after school such as fine arts, athletics, and work making it challenging to manage time to complete all tasks. MSHS understands that rest and sleep is essential for students to maintain a healthy lifestyle.

Schedule

Tuesdays and Thursdays 40 minutes following 1st hour. WIN bell schedule 2022/23	Students will have the opportunity to track grades, check emails, complete assignments/missing assignments, receive academic support and/or enrichment. Teachers may request that a student transfer during this time if there is a need to get caught up or have a specific skill to support or questions to be responded to.
Meeting Periods will be utilized on a M, W, or F.	Throughout the trimester there will be lessons led by WIN Time Teachers. (Examples: SEL, EDP's, Scheduling, PSAT/SAT test preparation.)

***Teachers will confirm WIN time student weekly schedules by Monday at noon.**

***Students and teachers will be able to view and confirm WIN time class assignments by Monday at 1pm.**

***During the Pilot:**

- February- Students will be assigned to their WIN teachers only, establish routines and expectations for use of WIN time. Build relationships**
- March-June- Teachers begin to assign students for intervention, enrichment or study/support.**

Expectations

WIN time is mandatory for all students at Mona Shores High School. Students will be expected to participate in discussions and complete all class activities.

Attendance:

Students will participate in classroom activities and in-class assignments during WIN Time. Attendance will be taken. If students are absent it is their responsibility to communicate with their WIN Time teacher and gather the necessary information.

What Happens During WIN Time?

- Students will check grades, assignments, email
- Test Makeup/retakes- Can utilize test center
- Content Support-Review of skills concept
- Quiet Study-Review vocabulary, review for quiz/tests, complete projects/papers
- Intervention-Target skill development, make up missing assignments
- Enrichment-Get feedback on assignments, tests, projects

What makes a successful WIN Time?

- Targeted instruction+Time=Learning
- Available to 100% of students
- Get help, get better, get ahead
- Student reflection on classes, workload and time management

How will students be scheduled for WIN Time? Teachers can:

- Be able to create a schedule for the week and plan for the next week. Create groups and easily schedule them for intervention/enrichment.
- See if a student has been requested by someone else
- Take attendance and know who to expect in WIN Time.
- Request students for WIN Time
- Create a schedule each week for those in most need of the support.
- Identify students who have not signed up for flex time.
