Please aim to complete three activities- try to pick a variety of curricular areas.

Literacy	Design a winter comic strip. Remember to use all your VCOP skills.	Write an autobiography of a famous north pole explorer. Can you find out any exciting facts?	Create a diary entry for your snow day and illustrate it. Use the questions who, what, where, when and how to help you.	Read for enjoyment.
Numeracy	Create a set of loop cards for your class where the answer to one is written on the next question.	Make a graph of how much snow has fallen.	Take a stride or a leap in the snow. Measure how far you can get. Can anyone in your house go further?	Talk to an adult about what you have been learning about in maths.
Health and Wellbeing	Create a leaflet to encourage people to look after their bodies. Think about hygiene, diet and exercise.	Dig a path in the snow for an elderly neighbour or family member.	Make a snow sculpture and take a photograph or draw a picture. How did you make it?	Have fun in the snow! Remember to keep safe and cosy!
Topic	Research your class topic using the internet or books. Can you find some fun facts to share with the class?	Ask an adult if they know anything about your topic. How did they find out the information?	Ask an adult what their topics were at school? What was their favourite? Is it similar or different to yours?
