Rules & Regulations

Approved by Board of Directors 1/16/2024

- 1. These Rules & Regulations apply at all times, 12 months a year.**
- 2. The beach opens daily at dawn and closes daily at 10:00 pm.**
- 3. No pets on the beach during Summer Season.**
- 4. Swim At Your Own Risk. No lifeguards are on duty.**
- 5. Keep off structures – they are dangerous.**
- 6. Keep off dunes & bluffs.**
- 7. All personal beach items must be removed from the beach each day by dusk. Boats may be stored overnight only at designated locations on or near the beach.**
- 8. Beach fires are permitted with the following conditions:**
 - a. Only when the wind is not blowing towards cottages or the Park.**
 - b. Fires may not be left unattended and must be fully extinguished before leaving beach.**
- 9. Boats may be launched and recovered only between red and green buoy-lined lanes.**

Welcome to Linwood Park!

We have made subtle changes around the lakefront to enhance the resilience of our beach, bluff, and dunes. So, please...



-  **DO** place your beach gear on the beach at least one foot from the edge of the dunes and bluff
-  **DO NOT** walk on sand dunes or move water craft & water devices across dunes – use designated paths
-  **DO** keep beach gear off dunes, off toe of bluff, and healthy vegetation, including beach grass

Sand Dunes and Beach Grass are Nature's free year-round snow fence. They help to capture sand to prevent it blowing away from the wind. This makes our beach, bluff, and dunes more resilient.

Water craft & large flotation devices may be stored on the beach overnight ONLY in the designated areas. ALL other beach gear must be removed from the beach DAILY.



-  Curving paths down through bluffs and dunes are more resilient than straight paths
-  Please only use pre-established paths to the beach
-  **Curved beach access paths can help build sand dunes too!**

Healthy dunes are the first line of defense when storms hit the beach. They protect the bluffs, infrastructure, and real estate. They can be rebuilt!



Please do not install new plants or prune, cut, or remove existing plants on Park Property without Park Board approval, including all property north of the sidewalk and the beach, bluff & dunes.



Launch and recover watercraft **ONLY** between the 2 designated locations on the beach marked by red and green markers or buoys



Kindly aid in preserving the purity of Our Beach by ensuring its cleanliness.



Vegetation growing north of the posts and ropes along the dunes and bluff will be "managed" while "grooming" will occur south of the posts and ropes.
