Tell me about who you book space for

Typical users of space

- Personal (Friends or family)
 - How close space needs to be to where they live/work
- o Professional use
 - Details of any community or voluntary group use
 - How close space needs to be to where they live/work

Tell me about how you find space to hire

- First action taken when needing a space to hire
 - Who they contact
 - How they contact them
 - Reason they take that action
 - What would they try next
- Most important considerations when looking for a space to hire
 - Any essential space requirements
 - Any desirable space requirements

Tell me about your experience of using community halls

- Reminder of the number of times they've used community halls
 - When first used
 - When last used
 - Which halls they've used
 - Preferred hall
 - Reason why

Tell me about the first time you used a community hall

- How they found out about community halls initially
- Reasons for needing space
 - what they were trying to achieve
- Space requirements
 - How many people
 - o Who
 - Budget
 - Length of time space needed
 - When it was needed
 - Amount of notice given
 - One off or repeat booking
- Reasons for contacting community halls
 - Other venue providers considered
- Method for contacting community halls
 - Channel(s)
 - First impressions
 - What happened next

Talk me through your experience of booking the hall

- Events following initial contact
 - Communication methods
 - Information asked to provide
 - Whether had to repeat information
 - Who you spoke to
 - Booking information provided
 - Anything missing that was needed
 - Anything confusing
 - Visiting the hall before booking
 - How was this arranged
 - What happened
 - Who did you talk to
 - What did they say
 - Information given about the hall
 - Any questions you asked
 - Impressions of the hall
 - Did the hall meet your expectations
 - Time taken to confirm booking
 - Number of interactions before booking confirmed
 - How booking confirmation received
 - Information provided including hall information
 - Anything missing that you needed
- Overall verdict of booking process
 - What went well
 - Any frustrations
 - Ideas for improvement

Tell me about your experience of paying for the hall

- Cost of room
- Opinion on price (ie affordability)
- When payment was made
- Method of payment
- Overall verdict on payment
 - What went well
 - Any frustrations
 - Ideas for improvement

Tell me about your experience of using the room

- Any steps following confirmation and the day of the event
- Information provided prior to going to venue

- What happened when you arrived at the hall
 - How did you get in
 - Who did you talk to
 - What did they say
- Any problems with the hall
 - Who did they go to
 - Did everything work as expected
 - Were all facilities available such as the kitchen
 - Setting up the hall
 - Experience of other attendees
- What happened after the event
- Any problems or frustrations

Tell me about the other times you've used a hall

- Any differences between first and subsequent experiences
- Best/worst experiences
 - Reasons why

Tell me about your views on community halls

- Would they use community halls again
 - Why
- o Comparison with experiences of using other venues
 - Awareness of other council spaces
- Any other frustrations community halls
- Ideas for improving community halls
- Feelings around availability of community halls in Hackney
 - Suitability
 - Affordability
