Sea Dragon Assemblies: These assemblies are held on Fridays during elective and other classes, Ms. Mora, our Assistant Principal and our staff run the assemblies. We cover our rules, procedures, culture and lots of awesome activities. Our first assembly on 8/22 is an introduction to staff around campus and student support information like buses, library and office use. Our second assembly is on 8/29 and this assembly is on dress code, keeping school clean and lunch services. Our third assembly is on 9/5. It is about school inclusive culture and clubs: ROV, Pride, Green Club, Softball, Surfing, Aptos Youth Group, Theater Arts, etc. Our last assembly is on 9/12. It is on computer use, internet safety, anti-bullying, and safety around school.

Sea Dragon Lessons: During the first couple of weeks in Advisory classes. Here are the topics covered:

- 1. Wed, School rules and procedures: bathroom passes, lunch/ break lines, bus lines and bus passes.
- 2. Thurs, Library and Digital Citizenship: library policies, chromebook insurance and procedures, internet safety.
- 3. Mon, Planner information: Attendance, dress code, electronic devices and confiscation.
- 4. Tues, Wellness Center: How do you see your counselors, support, self care, community circle. GPA and Grades: calculating grades, synergy checks, promotion requirements.
- 5. Wed, School Safety: emergency drills, safety procedures, notices, ALICE training, walk campus and rally points.

Attendance

Parents and Guardians have 3 days to excuse students from absences. Excused absences must fit within Ed Code 48205 visit state website for list of excused absences. Vacations are not excused absences. If students are absent for 3 or more days they need a doctor's note justifying absences. PE info from our Athletic Director, Mr. Schiro:

<u>Uniform Requirements:</u> All students wear a uniform consisting of athletic shoes, socks, PE shirt and shorts. Sweatpants or leggings may be worn instead of shorts but must be solid blue, black or gray.

<u>PE uniforms</u> may be purchased during the first week of school and throughout the year for \$25 (\$15 shorts, \$10 shirt). 5 Star is the best way to purchase a uniform. The link is located on the AJHS website under "Parent/Guardian" and "Purchases and Donations" - click on the Sea Dragon logo which will direct you further - we accept cash or credit card; no checks. We recommend that you purchase 2 uniforms to account for washing between uses.

An optional cinch bag is also available for \$10. Uniform sizes are not an option on the website; they are determined when you pick up your uniform in class. Each student will be assigned a locker at the beginning of the year to store uniforms.

Athletics:

Athletics begin in early September. Our first quarter sports offerings include boys and girls Cross Country, Girls Basketball, and Boys Soccer. Transportation is provided to away contests via buses. There is no charge to participate, however, a \$30 donation is appreciated.

Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA in their last grading period in order to participate. Athletic Sweatshirts are available for purchase during the year (\$35). All questions can be directed to **Mr. Schiro** (Athletic Director) - mike schiro@pvusd.net.

Bell Schedule/ Early Release Fridays

Please note that there is a new bell schedule starting in the fall. Bell Schedule Early Release Day is Fridays; on this day students are released at 12:55 pm and students may leave campus at that time. Lunchtime on Fridays is optional. Food Services will serve food from 12:55-1:05, Buses will load at 1:10, all remaining students will leave campus by 1:15 pm. Teachers are not available on Friday afternoons. Lockers

Lockers for general use are available on a first come first serve basis. Students need to fill out the form by September 5, 2025. Students need to fill out the google form and bring their own combination lock. Students need to provide the combination to the admin and are responsible for any lost or stolen items.

7th Grade Vaccinations

A reminder that all incoming 7th graders need to have a Tdap booster and 2 Varicella vaccines, or a medical exemption - or they will not be able to start school.

Bus Transportation (Z-Pass)

Our Transportation Department is now **accepting and processing bus pass applications** for the 2025–26 school year. If your student will be riding the bus, they **MUST** have a Z-Pass to board and exit the bus—no exceptions. These passes are part of our commitment to **student safety and real-time accountability**.

 Come by the Transportation Office before school starts to pick up your pass in person and skip the wait!

Can't Make It? No Problem:

If you're unable to pick up the pass, it will be delivered to your student's school site and given to their teacher before the first day. Each school will receive a list of who receives a pass to ensure every student is covered.
