Course Description

1 Semester- ½ credit

This course builds on previous knowledge of art. Understanding the Elements of Art and Principles of Design will evolve as work is produced using a variety of media such as pencil, paint, clay, printmaking, photography, and other Digital media. Students will evaluate visual expression from a variety of perspectives while developing creative and expressive solutions in their own work.

Course Objectives:

Visual Art Grade Level Expectations (GLE's) developed for Missouri Schools provide the objectives taught in art classes. The visual art Essential Understandings for Strands include:

- Artists communicate ideas through artworks by selecting and applying media techniques and processes, subject matter, and themes.
- Artists communicate ideas through artworks by selecting and applying art elements and principles
- Viewer's response aesthetically to artworks based upon their personal experience and culture values. Viewers analyze, interpret, and evaluate the quality of artwork through art criticism.
- Visual art is connected to performing arts, communications arts, math, science, and social studies.
- Visually literate citizens understand the role and functions of art in history and culture. Artists influence and are influenced by the cultures and time periods.
- The art curriculum requires the teaching of all 9th grade visual art objectives assigned from each strand. Assignments are designed for achieving proficiency on those objectives.

Google Classroom

I use google classroom to post assignments, tutorial videos and examples and scoring guides.

Evaluations:

The students will earn points from a variety of activities which include participation in a group of individual activities, writings, drawings, presentations, effort and use of class time. Scoring guides will provide the students with a clear understanding of what is expected for each activity. The art projects will best show achievement of most curricular objectives and growth in quality art making.

- Scoring guides for all projects will be posted on google classroom with every project.
- Projects will typically be graded within a week.
- I do not allow for Re-do's after an assignment has been graded.
