HOW DOES DOC TANK WORK?

Doc Tank 2016 is an intensive lab and meeting programme focused on documentary projects with transmedia and social engagement potential from all over the world, but preferably from Central and Eastern Europe.

Doc Tank will present up to seven **transmedia** projects (a story that can extend onto more than one platform) and projects with **campaign potential** with socio-eco-political engagement and activist approach.

Filmmakers selected for **Doc Tank** will participate at the 2-day intensive session with tutors and 1 day of individual meetings with international decision-makers, financiers and commissioners from the film, interactive, arts and broadcast industries at Project Market.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Free admission to the meetings for all of the attending participants.

Return travel & accommodation costs are on the expenses of participants.

Selection for Doc Tank offers participants free accreditation to the festival screenings and all industry events within One World Human Rights Documentary Film Festival.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Eligible are international applications, Central and East European projects are preferred. Doc Tank projects must span a combination of film, TV, online, mobile, interactive, publishing, live events and/or arts, science and human rights campaigns. Projects can be at any stage of development.

All application forms and supplementary materials must be received by December 1, 2015

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- proficiency in English
- all requested materials submitted prior to the deadline
- at least one person per project present personally at Doc Tank for the whole time
