Statement on Ongoing Lebanon Crisis

We in the Student Government Assembly mourn and recognize the loss of life, the injuries sustained, and destruction of infrastructure in Lebanon. We understand that emotions are high at this moment, and we stand with the NYU community as you navigate these incessant tragedies. We condemn the bombardment of Lebanon by Israel, which adds to the endless pain and suffering already present in Palestine. We extend our empathy to all those who were affected. We are concerned about the lack of acknowledgement of the attacks on Lebanon by the University, given their previous statements on the crises in the Middle East.

We are here to support you as a community and to advocate for you and your needs. We affirm the efforts being held by student leaders at NYU to support Lebanese relief efforts and will continue doing so. We recognize that this tragic situation affects many in our community from different backgrounds, religions, and ethnicities, and we believe that everyone deserves the opportunity to speak freely and without fear. No voice is unimportant. We encourage students and those affected to take the time to heal and take care of themselves and others. As SGA strongly opposes and highly discourages any form of targeted harassment, we advise that students are non-discriminatory in their words and actions.

In our belief in fostering a safe and healthy environment, we want to direct students to the various mental health, religious, academic, and other important resources at NYU.
