Budget Categories

Some budget groups can only be used for particular purposes

Title I is a large source of funds that usually goes towards additional staff support.

Expected Budget changes

LCFF increased by 3k to \$35,000

ELO/LREBG may be anywhere from \$0-85,000 (\$85,000 in 2023-2024)

Title I decreased from \$150,000 to \$114,000

Total: 2023-2024 = \$267,000. Total, 2024-2025 = \$149,000 - \$234,000

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District estimates that 69% of ELO positions were maintained. We could fund 100% at Ottomon. Up to the school board to approve this. They have a March 11th meeting scheduled.

69% = \$58,650; 100% = \$85,000.
