A Guide To Common Dental Procedures

While it's just easier to leave the job of understanding these dental terminologies to your dentist, it's also great to equip yourself with these ideas. Understanding these dental jargon will not just give you an edge, but could also keep you calm during your next dentist appointment.

You may be familiar with tooth extraction or a simple removal or decayed and cracked tooth. But here are some other dental procedures that you should know:

Dental Implants

If you lose a tooth, then a dental implant can be one option for you. Dental implants are used to replace missing tooth roots. During the procedure, a titanium screw is drilled into the jaw bone. They are used to secure a crown, bridge or denture.

Same Day Crowns

Crowns are used to cover a broken or decayed tooth. It can be made from either metal only or porcelain with metal. Crowns are also used for aesthetic.

Using advanced technology including a CAD/CAM (computer-aided design & computer-aided manufacturing), custom made dental crown can be made within a day. Dental crowns are shaped like a real tooth for you to have a natural-looking smile.

Root Canal Therapy

The root canal is the space from the center to the root of the tooth. Sometimes, this root canal can get infected often caused by a deep cavity or crack in the tooth. If not treated, the infection could damage the tooth as well. You can save the tooth through a root canal therapy.

Root canal therapy also known as endodontic treatment involves opening the tooth and removing any damaged pulp or nerve. During the procedure, the teeth are cleaned and filled with a filling or crown to avoid it from being infected again.

Dental Bridges and Dentures



A dental bridge is a process of replacing a missing tooth or teeth. During the procedure, artificial teeth made of metal and porcelain is attached adjacent to your natural teeth. Bridges can be removable or can be permanently attached.

On the other hand, dentures commonly known as false teeth are fitted to replace natural teeth. It consists of replacement teeth usually made from metal or plastic and attached to a pink or gum-colored acrylic base. They are removable so you can clean them like your natural teeth.

Dental Fillings

Dental fillings are used to restore teeth with cavities. Amalgam, which is made from a mixture of metals including mercury, silver, tin, copper, and zinc is a common filling used.

If you want a look more natural, you can opt for composite fillings. Composite fillings are shaded and shaped to blend with your natural teeth. The composite filling material uses a mixture of plastic and glass.

Scaling And Root Planing

Over time, a plaque that is left on the teeth can build up. And the only way to remove these deposits is through scaling and root planing. The procedure involves the removal of all accretions on the teeth and diseased root structure.

Microabrasion

Microabrasion is done when you have discolored spotty spots on your teeth. The process involves the use of mild acid compound applied on the teeth followed by a gentle scrubbing by your dentist.

Dental Veneers

If microabrasion is not enough for you, then dental veneer is the solution to your dilemma. Veneers are strong, thin pieces of porcelain that are bonded to the teeth to improve its appearance. They are also used to repair chipped or decayed teeth and may help in closing teeth gaps.
