## 2024-2025 Student Parking Information

Dear William Chrisman Student & Parent/Guardian:

All students sixteen years of age and older, with a permanent valid driver's license (not permit), are eligible to purchase a student parking permit for \$30.00 (discounted to \$15 for 2nd semester only), if they have provided the following information and meet the requirements:

- All obligations must be paid in full
- The following vehicle/driver information <u>must be provided at the time of application</u>:

- Students must provide proof of insurance
- This application must be signed by both the student and parent/guardian acknowledging WCHS parking policies
- In order to maintain parking permits for the second semester, students must meet the following conditions from the first semester:
  - No more than 8 excused/unexcused absences for any class;
  - No more than 5 class days missed due to ISS and/or OSS.

## I acknowledge and understand that:

- 1. Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right.
- 2. The Independence School District and its agents retain authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property.
- 3. The Independence School District and its agents may inspect the interiors of student automobiles whenever a school authority has reasonable suspicion to believe illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside the automobile.
- 4. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant.
- 5. If a student fails to provide access to the interior of their car upon request by school officials, they will be subject to school disciplinary action.
- 6. Parking violations will result in the following consequences:
  - a. 1st offense: \$30.00 ticket/fee will be added to the student's obligation account.
  - b. 2nd offense: \$40.00 ticket/fee will be added to the student's obligation account.
  - c. 3rd offense: \$50.00 ticket/fee will be added to the student's obligation account.
  - d. Any offense beyond the 3rd ticket/fee will result in parent/guardian involvement and possible loss of parking privileges.

I have read and understand the school regulations regarding student parking at William Chrisman High School. I further agree to follow these regulations and operate my vehicle in a safe, respectful, and defensive manner. Lastly, I understand that failure to comply with the school regulations may result in any or all of the following: disciplinary actions, loss of parking privileges, legal consequences and/or vehicle being towed at the owner's expense.
