When I was a junior in high school, there were several Situation students in my math class who were struggling with some of the more difficult and complex concepts. With an upcoming national exam, I was asked by Task my math teacher to start an after school session to assist the other students. I stayed after school twice a week to review class materials and homework. I created a comprehensive study guide. I demonstrated the Action best methods for solving difficult problems, explained strategies that worked for me, and developed new problems to help them practice. Our class average for the national exam was the highest it had Result been in over ten years, and overall the students I helped were able to develop a better understanding and appreciation for math.
