CURRICULUM

IXL

This year students will continue to use IXL as a practice and review tool. IXL uses insights from student work in the curriculum and the Real-Time Diagnostic to **generate personalized guidance for each learner**. These personalized action plans seamlessly link students to the skills that will help them build on their knowledge and remediate gaps in understanding.

Students will at times be assigned work to at least a smart score of 80, which is proficient or mastery level. Since this is an honors math class, most times students will be expected to reach a score of 100 unless told otherwise.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM

We will continue to use Google Classroom at times. Google Classroom will not be utilized everyday, however, at times students will be expected to obtain and/or turn in their work through this platform, especially if there is an asynchronous day.

MATERIALS

Students are expected to bring the appropriate and necessary materials to each and every class. This includes:

pencils (NO PENS)

erasers

highlighter

colored pencils (for projects throughout the year)

binder

workbook

assignment book

CHARGED chromebook

self adhesive hole reinforcement stickers (for binder use)

I have plenty of rulers and calculators. Calculators are mainly only used in 7th & 8th grade.

CLASSROOM RULES

BEHAVIOR

Students have been made aware that if there is an infraction they will receive two in class warnings (verbal, then a second reminder), then a “caution” will be sent home via FACTS. If this same infraction continues a “warning” will be sent via FACTS. Last, a demerit with points will be sent home via FACTS. I will also utilize FACTS for “merits” or positive notes home! (Please see the student handbook above.)

HOMEWORK

Homework is an important part of learning and mastering math concepts. Students should expect to have math homework Monday through Thursday in order to reinforce concepts taught during class. **All homework will be posted daily on the 6th Grade homework tracker.**

LATE HOMEWORK

Students are expected to complete assignments on time. In the event of an absence, it is the student’s responsibility to check my website, and or with his/her classmate for missed work and notes. If there are extenuating circumstances that caused the assignment to be late, parents should email me. All late assignments will be accepted, if turned in within the time frame of that unit. If the unit has been completed, it is the teacher’s discretion, whether or not to accept the assignment.

WEIGHTED GRADING SCALE

60% tests/major projects
30% quizzes/minor projects
10% classwork/participation

TEST CORRECTIONS

At times, students have a bad testing day, therefore, students will be permitted to complete “test corrections” in the event they receive below an 80% on a test (no quizzes). This is optional and students must see me in private to coordinate the test corrections. Students can earn back $\frac{1}{2}$ of the points per question they reanswer correctly.

TEST/QUIZ SCORES

Students are given all scores in confidentiality and are encouraged not to discuss their scores with others as grades are personal. If students would like to see their grade average they can see me in private or check FACTS with their family.

BINDER GUIDELINES

- Students must have their binder every day to organize and record their work.
- Notes and examples should be dated and labeled neatly. **ONLY PENCIL SHOULD BE USED ON ALL MATH WORK. Red pen for corrections is fine if done neatly. BINDERS ARE A RESOURCE and can be used for homework, etc.**

OFFICE HOURS

I will hold office hours in my classroom daily from 2:00 - 2:30 for students who need to make up tests or quizzes or for extra help.
