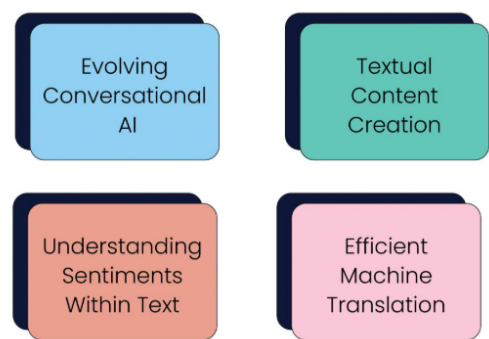
3. Results and Discussion
