TITLE: Sexual Assault Awareness Month Programming Bill

I. Purpose

The purpose of this bill is to purchase materials that the Health and Wellness Committee will utilize and distribute to students. This also bill recognizes the programming that the Health and Wellness Committee currently has slated for the month of April, which is widely recognized as Sexual Assault Awareness Month.

II. Rationale

WHEREAS, April is widely recognized as Sexual Assault Awareness Month, which is meant to raise awareness, educate communities, and promote the prevention of sexual violence.

WHEREAS, ASBSU has historically engaged in highlighting and educating students with efforts hosted by the previously-active Sexual Violence Prevention Advocacy Committee and individual events.

WHEREAS, ASBSU recognizes the heightened concerns involving safety and Sexual Assaults on-campus.

WHEREAS, ASBSU wants to provide educational and awareness opportunities for students to be connected with resources throughout Boise.

WHEREAS, the Inclusive Excellence Standing Committee and the Health and Wellness Committee will dedicate ourselves to introduce future legislation that will go further into depth regarding the importance of Sexual Assault Awareness Month recognition and education.

WHEREAS, ASBSU's current slate of programming will include both educational and community-building events, including a Chalk the Quad event and a Self-Defense Class.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that \$82.95 will be allocated from the ASBSU Sponsored Projects Budget to purchase the items listed in the provision section of this Bill.

III. Account Drawn From

Funds will be withdrawn from the ASBSU sponsored projects budget.

IV. Provisions

- A. \$82.95 will be allocated from the ASBSU Sponsored Projects Budget to the Campus Food Pantry department fund.

- B. The provisions of this bill will go into effect immediately upon the signature of the President and Vice President of ASBSU.

V. Fiscal Impact

This Bill will have a total Fiscal Impact of \$82.95, which will be drawn from the ASBSU Sponsored Projects Budgets.
