

Results from June 2 Exit Survey:

What are some thing you want to see improve in NHS next year?

- Communication between advisors/officers and members, and stronger organization, especially with email and Google drive, use text reminders for service projects
- More involvement and participation for members, more than just the meetings, better inclusion of all members
- More service projects and volunteer opportunities
- Equal balance of work between school district and community, do more work with those in need in the community
- More meetings
- More fun activities
- Increase productivity and begin meetings faster so that we get more done
- Earlier notice for service projects (note: this is not possible for volunteer opportunities)
- Hold members more accountable for their attendance, make sure that everyone's attending meetings
- Begin service/volunteer projects earlier in the year

What are some goals you have for the organization?

- Let others know what NHS is, especially underclassmen (including work within the school to help people see what we do), make NHS more well-known and give it a good name, including within the community
- Do more service projects and plan fun activities
- 50 community service hours for each member by the end of the year
- Do more work for charitable organizations (Caritas)
- More work as a group, more group interaction
- Work with elementary/middle school age kids in our district and get them excited about NHS and about learning, and prepared for high school

- Have each member feel like they are fully contributing and that they are the best member they can be
