PRESENT SIMPLE - VERB (S-he, she, it)

Ex. – You sleep. She sleeps.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS – am, are, is Ving

Ex. I am talking now. She is leaving. It is raining.

- I (speak) on the phone now. _____
- It (snow.) _____
- You (take) too much time. _____
- Larry (play) now. _____

PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE –have, has 3rd form

Ex. I have been busy. She has left. They have gone.

- You (lose) your keys. _____
- They (be) here. _____
- Mary (buy) wine already. _____
- She (call) several times. _____
- I never (see) such a storm. _____

PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS- have, has been Ving

Ex. I have been trying to reach you. They have been learning since yesterday. She has been learning English for 10 years.

- She (call) for hours. _____
- They (paint) since this morning. _____
- He (write) for an hour. _____
- We (live) here for 5 years. _____
- It (snow) for hours. _____

PAST TENSE

PAST SIMPLE – ED, forma 2 neregulate

Ex. I walked. You danced. He left. They ate.

- I (be) there. _____
- You (fly) by Whizz. _____
- She (come) home. _____
- He (lose) his way. _____
- We (buy) fruit. _____

PAST CONTINUOUS – was, were Ving

Ex. I was sleeping at 10 last night. We were dining out last week, on Thursday evening..

- I (read) at 5 yesterday. _____
- You (eat) lunch when the phone rang. _____
- I (take) shower when you came. _____
- He (work) at 5, yesterday. _____
- I (leave) when they called me. _____

PAST PERFECT SIMPLE –Had 3rd form

Ex. She had left already when I looked for her. By the time he came, we had finished the work.

- I (close) the shop when the customers came. _____
- She (do shopping) when I found the list. _____
- It (rain) before I left. _____
- You (train) athletes when you became a trainer. _____
- They (build) a house before they moved in. _____

PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS- Had been Ving

Ex. She had been trying to open the door before I arrived. They had been working till 10 when they stopped.

- He (dig) in the garden before the rain started. _____
- They (fix) the pipe before the water came. _____
- I (read) a lot before I started writing. _____
- She (work) without breaks before she left. _____
- The cat (sleep) the whole evening before I put it out. _____

FUTURE TENSE

FUTURE SIMPLE – Will verb, going to, be to, Present Continuous, Present Simple

Ex. I will call you. The tree is going to fall. We are leaving tomorrow. The train leaves at 8.

- She (buy) a new car. _____
- I (read) this book. _____
- The children (go) to school next week. _____
- My neighbor (go) to work at 5 tomorrow morning. _____
- They (fill) in these forms next week. _____

FUTURE CONTINUOUS – will be Ving

Ex. Mary will be flying to Paris at this time tomorrow. They will be building a highway next May.

- I (eat out) at noon, next week. _____
- You (lie) on the beach this time, tomorrow. _____
- They (work) at noon, tomorrow. _____
- You (work) in Spain next month. _____
- It (snow) this time, in December. _____

FUTURE PERFECT – Will have 3rd form of verb

Ex. They will have finished the work until tomorrow. She will have graduated until July.

- He (finish) this work by this time tomorrow. _____
- The plane (arrive) until 3 o'clock. _____
- They (have) lunch until 2 o'clock. _____
- We (go) till the afternoon. _____
- They (buy) the materials until they start building. _____

FUTURE PERFECT CONTINUOUS – will have been Ving
