- Christina is attending the Autism Conference virtually this week.
- Jordan had asked a question regarding an MDT meeting they are having tomorrow. She doesn't feel like he should be picked up for articulation as there is no data supporting to show that intervention was not working. Jordan has provided teachers with information on how to produce the sound and teachers have been providing the interventions. She is looking at the speech continuum to help her make this decision. Jordan wanted to know how others are providing interventions.
 - Melissa has provided activities for teachers to do with students (e.g. Go Fish, Matching) and a way for them to record them having done the activity with the student using a Google Doc form. Then the SLP checks in to see if progress is being made.
 - Christina uses Speedy Speech in which she gives a packet to take home and gives to teachers. She uses this when there is typically only 1 sound in error. She provides training for the teacher and will pull the student to the back of the class or outside of the classroom for a few minutes one time per week. She also uses a coarticulation web.
- Melissa had a question regarding a student that she has who refuses to talk in most situations and when he does, it is in the briefest way possible. He is currently receiving services under articulation, however has demonstrated accurate production when reading and he demonstrates periods in which he will talk because he thinks that he will not have to go to speech anymore. He was recently re-evaluated to determine dismissal from speech, however the school wants me to continue to see him under the verification of Emotional Disturbance, because his speech is often broken up. Others in this meeting felt that that is not appropriate to keep him on for speech if his articulation and language skills are intact.
