Grades 6-8 (excluding RECMS Pre-AP for All 8th Grade Class)

- Teachers in grades 6-8 will use myPerspectives as their core reading program with fidelity.
- Teachers will utilize the district-created pacing guide for myPerspectives and the myPerspective unit maps.
 - The myPerspectives pacing guides will replace the district-created pacing guides.

Grades 9-10 Pre-AP for ALL (including RECMS Pre-AP for All 8th Grade Class)

- Teachers will use the Pre-AP for All framework. ALL texts and resources to support the Pre-AP for All framework MUST come from myPerspectives and/or Pre-AP resources and/or Pre-AP Springboard.
- Please ensure that scholars complete at least one Pre-AP for All Learning Checkpoint per unit.
 - These will be found in your Pre-AP digital classroom. These should take one class to complete.
- Please ensure that scholars complete the four Pre-AP for All Performance tasks throughout the year.
 - These will take one-to-two days to complete and build in complexity.
- Teachers may choose to use the Pre-AP for All Final Exam. It is recommended, but not required.
- Please share the myPerspectives student workbooks with scholars. This is their copy and they should annotate and write in them as you assign texts and assignments. The myPerspective student workbooks are renewed each year.

- Please share the Pre-AP Student Reader Unit books with scholars. This is their copy and they can annotate and write in them as you assign texts and assignments. The Pre-AP Student Reader Unit books are renewed each year.
- Please do NOT allow scholars to write in the Pre-AP Springboard student workbooks and Workshop books (as you will not receive new workbooks next year.)
