While the new DEA form is beautifully fast to propose and tech review, the backend processes still take time. And remember that in spring, DEA timelines will align with outline processing timelines and will need to be taken care of a year in advance of effectiveness, not just one semester. This should lessen some of the chaos.
- When revising courses that are part of a distinct sequence or that go together (e.g., CORS 32A, 32B, and 32C), please modify them together so that there is more consistency and less tension in the overall review/revision process. Similarly, when a course outline is revised, its addenda should also be updated since they are bound together. They're a set. Like a pantsuit!

This is a great alternative to the [course outline crib notes](#). Just imagine looking at both of those resources when you begin to create or modify an outline.
