Lesson Policies & Expectations

Student Expectations

Students are expected to:

- be on time for their lessons. If a student is late, they will receive a shortened lesson; teachers will generally not be able to teach past the end of the lesson time.
- have their own instruments to play both at lessons and at home. With the exception of piano and drum students, students must bring their own instruments to lessons.
 Guitar/bass students do not need to bring amplifiers or cables.
- Bring their lesson books and notes to each lesson.
- be respectful to the teachers and staff at Rossi Music.
- practice regularly.

Teachers may discontinue working with students who do not meet these expectations.

Invoices

Invoices will be automatically emailed 3 days before the beginning of each month and are due on the 8th. You will find payment methods listed on the bottom of the invoice. Rates

In order to get the weekly lesson rate, you are booking a slot of the teacher's time for a month-long period, which means the entire month must be paid even if the student will not be attending every session.

Student-Missed Lessons & Make-Ups

Unless arranged by the teacher there are no refunds on missed lessons, but we do offer reschedules. If you cannot attend a lesson, please give us 24 hours notice and we will issue you a make-up credit. No call/no shows will not receive make-up credits. We will be lenient with the occasional last minute cancellation; if canceling day-of please reach out to your teacher directly.

Make-up credits can only be used to book a lesson outside of the normal lesson time slot. So long as you continue your monthly lessons, there is no time limit for when make-up credits must be used. Extended Absences

If lessons must be missed for more than one week, students have the following options:

- 1. Pay 100% of lesson fees and schedule make-up lessons upon return (see "Student-Missed Lessons & Make-Ups" for details)

- 3. Discontinue lessons and re-enroll upon return (lesson time may no longer be available upon return)

If your teacher must miss your lesson, they will try to reschedule with you around your preferences. If you cannot come to a suitable reschedule time, you will receive a credit for the lesson (\$30) on your next invoice.
