Read the Passage James 1:5-8; 3:13-18 Wisdom as God's generous gift

Have someone read the passage aloud.

Clarify, retell what happens in the passage.

Discover and Explore God's Word

What did you like, what surprised you, what confused you?

What does this passage tell us about: God, people, relationship between God and people? Can we see Jesus in our passage, or our need for Jesus?

Believe, Repent, Change

How does this passage change how you view God, yourself, or other people?

If I believe this and take it seriously, what would I need to change in my beliefs, attitudes, and actions?

What can I praise God for showing me in this passage?

Prayer response

What needs can I/we meet this week?

Who could I tell this to?

Who can I be praying for? Specifically those who don't yet trust in Jesus.
