The conference will be held on **May 14, 2026** at the Oleksandr Dovzhenko Hlukhiv National Pedagogical University in a ***remote-correspondence*** form.

Researchers, academic and teaching staff, educators, doctoral students, postgraduate students, and higher education students are invited to participate in the conference.

TOPICS OF THE CONFERENCE:

1. Modern innovative approaches to the development of technological and vocational education in the context of European integration.
2. Scientific and methodological foundations for modernizing the content, tools, and teaching technologies in the field of technological and vocational education.
3. Implementation of the conceptual principles of specialized general secondary education.

4. Ensuring the quality of vocational education in view of the challenges of post-war economic recovery and development.
5. Formation of entrepreneurial competence and career development of future specialists to enhance their competitiveness in the modern labor market.
6. Digitalization of the educational process: digital tools, platforms, and AI for technological and vocational training.

Official languages of the conference: Ukrainian, English.

Form of participation: remote-correspondence.

Based on the results of the conference, free publication of participants' scientific papers is planned in the electronic proceedings of the conference.

We kindly ask you to check scientific papers for the percentage of similarity using the software available to you and to submit a screenshot of the verification results indicating the software used.

Conference participants should submit their materials by email to the Organizing Committee at kaftpo@gmail.com, indicating «**TPO conference 2026**» in the subject line:

- conference paper abstracts (2–5 pages) prepared in accordance with the specified requirements (see below);
- a screenshot of the results of the similarity check of the abstracts, indicating the software used;
- peer review of the abstracts (for students, if required).

The names of the submitted files must correspond to the surname of the first author of the presentation, for example: «Shevchenko_Application», «Shevchenko_Abstracts».

Students can participate in the conference if co-authored with a teacher or with the review of a Candidate or Doctor of Sciences.

The Editorial Board carries out an independent (blind) review of the submitted materials and performs additional peer review. No discussion regarding the reasons for rejection is conducted.

The authors bear full responsibility for submitting papers that have been previously published or accepted for publication by other editions.

The electronic proceedings of the conference are planned to be published after the event. An electronic copy (PDF format) will be sent to the conference participants by email.

Each participant will receive an electronic certificate. It certifies the participation in the event or the publication of theses, and recommends the enrollment of 0.2 ECTS credit (6 hours) or 0.3 ECTS credit (9 hours), respectively.

Texts prepared only in Microsoft Word format are accepted for editing

The list of used literature sources is given at the end of the text in alphabetical order under the name «References» one line after the main text. References should be written according to the APA (American Psychological Association) style.

In case the submitted materials do not comply with the stated requirements, the Organizing Committee reserves the right not to include them in the conference proceedings without additional revision by the authors.

You can submit an article for publication of articles in a scientific printed journal «BULLETIN OF OLEKSANDR DOVZHENKO HLUKHIV NATIONAL PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY. PEDAGOGICAL SCIENCES», which is included in the List of scholarly professional editions of Ukraine of «B» category (Decree of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine № 1471 of the 26th of November 2020) at the expense of the authors.
