

SHINE: Road to Cosmic Dreams #004

Shinjuku FACE, Tokyo, Japan September 13th, 2024

The opening camera shot panned into the ring, not the usual match look as there was a velvet red mat with a podium in the center of the ring, a small table right next to it with an item covered by a black sheet over it. Kita Hikari was waiting to address the fans, standing in the center of the ring next to the podium.

KITA HIKARI: Hello, everyone! As you all know, the High Speed championship has been rather eventful the last month. From a shocking new champion, to the previous title belt being destroyed. I want to take the time now to introduce to you... the NEW SHINE High Speed Champion, Masami Tsuchiya!

"BLAZE LINE" by BACK-ON blasted through the speakers, most of the fans' attention going to the curtain. In usual fashion to her entrance, Tsuchiya kept the crowd waiting for the vocals kicked into the song, which took around thirty-five seconds. Masami stepped into a SHINE venue for the first time, looking around to the fans with a look of confidence on her face. The High Speed Champion wore an all black suit, with blood red accessories to go with it, being the tie and the dress shirt underneath. There was a long black cape to the back of the jacket. MASAMI TSUCHIYA (whispering, off-mic): Now get the fuck out of my ring before I put you through as much pain as that pathetic champion of yours when I took this.

Kita's expression wasn't a happy one, but the owner of SHINE exited the ring while Masami Tsuchiya took her place on the podium, leaning into the microphone.

MASAMI TSUCHIYA: Now! We can finally get down to proper business. For those who didn't see SCRAMBLE's Grand Slam, I am the one who caused the entire downward spiral of Akane Yamashita's career. I forced this fake masochist to quit. No, Akane didn't tap out. But that just means I beat her until she couldn't continue. Not bad for my first match under both the SCRAMBLE and SHINE banners. you do your job for once and set up a match to determine who challenges me for the SHINE High Speed Championship...

Masami paused for a second.

MASAMI TSUCHIYA: ...in a Submission match at SCRAMBLE's Cosmic Battleground!

The crowd booed this immediately which caused Tsuchiya to chuckle.

MASAMI TSUCHIYA: Aww, I know, I know, you all want me to defend this in SHINE. That time will come, but I'm not being paid enough to wrestle at the moment! So, you'll just get appearances and these little speeches for now. Don't be mad at me, but be mad at your boss for expecting me to wrestle for a few Yen. Anyways! I will proudly represent this championship and what it's supposed to stand for. I am SHINE's hero now, and I will be the hero that you all want. Just remember everyone, just when you think that there's a dark cloud swarming around SHINE, I will be there to save you!

Tsuchiya raised the championship belt into the air as red and silver confetti rained down from above the ring, prompting Masami to pose with the title belt while the confetti kept raining down. Tsuchiya's music began playing again so the new champion exited the ring, walking back to the curtain with the title on her shoulder. She waved one final time to the fans before disappearing to the back.



Sensing an opportunity, she turned her attention to Kadlec, delivering a brutal snap DDT that laid her out in the center of the ring.

Melanie seized the moment, hitting her finisher on Kadlec and covering her for what looked like a sure victory. But just as the referee's hand was coming down for the three-count, Sonya darted back into the ring, dragging Melanie off of Kadlec and breaking up the pin. The two former partners exchanged heated words, the tension between them boiling over!

As their argument escalated, Sonya made her move, hitting Melanie with her finisher as a final Fuck You. She stood over her former partner, satisfied with her work, but in the chaos, Kadlec saw her chance. She grabbed Sonya, tossing her out of the ring and quickly covered the downed Melanie.

DEVI KRYSIS: "Now on to the topic in hand, yeah, not the outcome that I wanted as the piece of footage showed that Kimberley Stark reminded me and the rest of the locker room that this is the era of The Kim!"

HANNAH WALSH: "Well with Kimberley Stark defeating you, it's pretty much back of the line at least for now. But let's speak about Wundercardl you're in the crowd watching the Women of both SHINE and Valkyrie Wrestling showcasing their talents in the ring. What matches really stand out for you?"

DEVI KRYSIS: "Well the Valkyrie Tag Team Championship Gauntlet Match was pretty fierce because the Valkyrie Tag Team division is already taking it to new heights! SHW x Valkyrie Gore and Glory Championship match was pretty brutal. Akane Yamashita vs. Ayano Kyotani was a great match credit to both of them. Kasey Connery with the impressive open challenge as always. Battle of the Asses match is pretty wild, Selena has the better ass. *wink* *wink* and the champion vs champion main event couldn't end differently due Antoinette winning the Valkyrie World Championship but I know that Kira Karnstein will regain the title soon! Above all Wundercard was a huge and stunning success! Hopefully Discus Devi will compete in Germany one of these days!"

HANNAH WALSH: "Well with Wundercard out of the way and after losing to the SHINE World Champion Kimberley Stark what's next for the Discus Devi?

I've been in this company since day 1 and the gods of the Island of Violence is pissed and growing restless but Kita Hikari and backstage politics gets in the way, and they need to see me counting bodies and headlining matches and I'm willing to work and earn my way for an opportunity! So the SHINE locker room better be on guard because Discus Devi is going hunting! For Championships!"

HANNAH WALSH: "Well a very bold statement from Devi Krysis as she is willing to bounce back from her loss against Kimberley Stark as she leaves the SHINE World Championship hunt to anyone who wants to go after it and pursue with other Championships how will other champions respond? Till then let's get back to the action!"

Kawaii Cup Pink League CHET vs Wildchild Tsuuyuki



The bell rang, and CHET immediately charged at Tsuuyuki, trying to use her raw power to gain the early advantage. 
With Olivia laid out in the center of the ring, Nadia hooked the leg, and the referee counted to three, giving Nadia her first victory in SHINE.

Kimberley turned her attention to Ayano first, kicking her out of the ring before setting her sights on Seldon. Stark, looking to make a statement, attempted to deliver the Starkbuster to Seldon, but the challenger slipped out. In a flash, Lisa hit Kimberley with the Evil Dead II, laying her out cold in the center of the ring.

As Kimberley rolled out of the ring, seething in fury, Ayano Kyotani re-entered and noticed Kimberley's World Championship lying on the mat. She picked it up, staring at it longingly—remembering the days when it was hers. Before Kyotani could do anything further, Seldon snatched the title out of her hands, raising it high above her head.

Kimberley, leaning against the barricade on the outside, glared daggers at both Kyotani and Seldon. Lisa taunted her, holding the championship aloft as the crowd erupted, knowing full well that Kimberley's reign was in jeopardy. The show ended with the three women locked in a tense, unspoken standoff, each knowing that the battle for the SHINE World Championship was far from over.
