VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL OF ACCREDITATION AND MEMBERSHIP

Because the decision to become a candidate or an accredited member of the Commissions on Elementary and Secondary Schools is voluntary, a school may choose to relinquish its accredited status and membership at any time. Schools wishing to withdraw from membership shall submit this request in writing.

If a school voluntarily relinquishes its accreditation and membership, it shall remove all references in its publications, materials, and website that the school is accredited or a candidate for accreditation by the Middle States Association's Commission on Elementary and Secondary Schools. Failure to remove all references within 90 days of withdrawal of accreditation and membership may result in legal action by the Commission.

Schools withdrawing accreditation and membership are still responsible for any unpaid invoices owed to the Middle States Association.
