Principal's Report - Pam

- Gaga Ball Pit - Previously council approved the allocation of \$1500
 - Cost has gone up to \$2500 with HST (not including prep)
 - Up to \$7000+ including labour & materials
 - WRDSB Facilities Dept. recommendations: consider using professional products, excavate to 8" depth (about a dump truck load of dirt) and fill with stone dust to facilitate drainage
 - With the cost increase above what was already allocated, more fundraising may be required.
 - Stephanie asked for an informal vote on whether council is in favour of continuing with exploration of funding for the gaga ball pit - approx half in favour to continue
- EQAO
 - Grade 6s May 29th - June 2nd



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- Grade 3s June 5th - 9th
- Classroom events
 - More events happening,
 - Kindies went to see "The Claw"
 - Grade 4s doing a sports thing on Friday
 - Kindies going to Kate's Place
 - Vision Team, mobility & orientation from CCAC(?) working with 4/5s to do sight guided site touring, working with a blind student at JMA as part of their growth goals in participating in nutrition break outdoors. Had a blind student from EDSS come and talk to the class
 - Grade 6 camp is approved!
 - Cost for camp has gone up
 - Grade 6 celebration
 - June 27th at 12-1pm
 - Are siblings from the school invited, or just parents? Pam to look into
 - Jungle Sport May 23-26th
 - Staff information, some teachers have come back from leave
 - Teacher assignments for next year looks relatively close to the same as it is this year
 - Kindergarten registration is still down
 - French Immersion
 - 58% French (Language, Social Studies, Math, Phys. Ed/Health, Dance/Drama/Music) 42% (Language, Math, Science)
 - Finalization of the french subjects and teacher assignments is still ongoing

Treasury Report - Renee

- Additional 3rd round pizza sales of \$5,082 net of school day fees (actual)
 - 5 Pizza invoices paid totaling \$2,801 (net of HST rebate)
 - School day fees of \$74 paid
 - Accrue pizza invoices of \$6,000 (less prior month accrual)
- Mabel's Label (\$68) and Tru-Earth (\$22) cheques deposited
- Pancake day expenses paid totaling \$297 (net of HST rebate)
- Picnic table invoice paid totaling \$1,072 (net of HST rebate)
 - Note: This was paid from the general cash account instead of the WEFI account
 - the invoice total was more than the approved amount of \$800
 - **Motion to approve over-spend on picnic table - Stephanie**
 - Due to there not being enough voting members present, vote to happen via email after the meeting
 - **Motion to approve an additional \$272 in spending to cover the cost increase of the picnic table via email from Stephanie on May 10th**
 - **Passed: by majority vote**
- Paid \$174 to volunteer lanyards purchase
- Paid \$654 for the Current Year fundraising initiative (\$300/19 classes + Rotary teachers)

 - T-shirt purchases \$76
 - Data projector \$1,200

Open Discussion - All

- French volunteer would like to host a french book fair in September - Pam
- Grade 6 Camp \$12,407.40, busing \$1700+,
 - \$262.20 per student - with no fundraising
 - With funds from school council and student fundraising, the cost is down to \$140 per student
 - Would like to reduce the cost to \$100 per student. To do that they need \$2,240 more
 - Kristen/Stephanie/Leanne to look into how much was raised from Pita sales this year to help offset the cost
 - Followup discussion & vote to happen via email on whether the council will contribute more funds to help bring the cost down.
- Teacher request for Freezies or Popsicles for Jump Rope for Heart
 - **Motion to spend up to \$125 on freezies for June 15th Jump Rope for Heart event - Stephanie**
 - Due to there not being enough voting members present, vote to happen via email after the meeting
 - **Motion to approve spending of up to \$125 for freezies via email from Stephanie on May 10th**
 - **Passed: by majority vote**

Additional discussion / activities after the meeting

- Email from Kristen on Tuesday May 16th
 - Received a funding request for \$250 for the Grade 6 Celebration (same as what we gave last year)
 - **Motion to approve \$250 in spending to go towards Grade 6 Celebration**
 - **Passed: by majority vote**
- Email from Kristen on Wednesday May 17th



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- The sound system in the school gym has unfortunately broken (not only used in the gym for assemblies and events, but used outside as well for events). The ask is for \$2,000 - \$2,500. We should vote on the maximum cost of \$2,500.
 - **Motion to approve up to \$2500 in spending to replace the sound system**
 - **Passed: 18 votes YES, 0 votes NO**
- As discussed at the Council meeting, there is a request for \$1,000 towards the cost of the Grade 6 Camp Kintail trip. Costs are much higher this year because it is an overnight trip, and also 2 buses are required this year due to having to transport bags along with people.
 - **Motion to approve \$1,000 towards the cost of the Grade 6 Trip**
 - **Passed: 15 votes YES, 3 votes NO**
