Daily Schedule

Student Technology

A SDC staff member **MUST** lead any activities that involve technology and must use the LISD-approved curriculum located on the LISD Learning Hub website.

Lunch/Snack

Meals and snacks are provided by Child Nutrition. **Campers receive a mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack daily, and lunch is served around 11:40 AM.**

Campers are not required to bring lunch unless they prefer not to eat the provided meal or have dietary restrictions/allergies that prevent them from eating the items on that day's menu.

Please ensure your child's allergy information is up to date in Eleyo and inform camp staff of any dietary concerns.

What to wear:

Operations Policies SUMMER 2025

LISD SUMMER DAY CAMP/ JUNE 2nd THROUGH JULY 11th

Parents, please read: Your child's safety is our top priority

LISD Summer Day Camp operates for six weeks during June and July from Monday through Friday. Hours are 7 am to 6:00 pm.

Camp is closed on Thursday, June 19, and Friday, July 4, 2025.

No child will be allowed to attend the program without the following completed forms: Permission Slips, Temporary Guardianship, Medical History/ Medication forms, and Allergy Action Plan Form (if needed).

Under no circumstance will children be allowed to leave the school without a parent (or designated adult at least 18 years old). Staff are not authorized to release children until they can verify the identity of the adult picking up. Please have photo identification to show staff when picking up your child. Authorized Pick-Up adults must be listed in your Eleyo Profile.

Illnesses and Injuries

LISD Summer Day Camp follows LISD policies during the school year regarding illnesses and injuries and administering medication.

If your child becomes sick, injured, or exposed to a contagious illness while attending camp, you will be notified immediately by phone or in writing when your child leaves, depending on the severity of the injury or illness.

If your child becomes ill while attending LISD Summer Day Camp, he or she will be kept separate from other children, and we will call you immediately to pick up your child from camp. If your child is sent home from camp with a fever, he or she must be fever-free, without fever-reducing medication, for 24 hours before returning to camp. If your child is sent home due to a contagious illness, we will inform you of the conditions to be met before he or she can return to camp.

Unfortunately, we will not issue refunds if your child misses a portion of camp due to illness or injury.

All Medication

Children are not allowed to carry their medication; all medication is stored in the camp office at the LISD Summer Day Camp location. Directors and supervisors will administer medication as needed. A note will be sent home to inform parents when medication has been given.

Per TX Licensing policy, we will not give your child any medication without authorization from you. Prescription or non-prescription medication must arrive at camp in its original packaging with instructions and the Medication Form. Physician written authorization required: If your child requires medication for more than 15 days, you will need to provide us with a letter from your child's physician stating this information.

LISD SDC camps will not have an unassigned EpiPen. Students with allergies that require an EpiPen will need to bring one.

Staff Immunizations - We do not require our LISD Summer Day Camp staff to obtain immunizations.

Visitor Policy

Parents and guardians are welcome to visit us anytime during LISD Summer Day Camp! However, if you plan to be a regular guest, you will be asked to follow LISD volunteer procedures for criminal history checks and volunteer clearance. For security reasons, parents will not be permitted to linger or interact with students



other than their own when picking up their students. Children not enrolled are not able to attend or participate in activities for liability and supervision reasons.

If you would like to join us on a field trip, please note our special requirements for parent volunteers. For the safety of your child and all LISD Summer Day Camp campers, we ask that you do not "drop in" on a field trip activity.

All parents attending field trips must be cleared under LISD volunteer background check procedures. Field trip parents must ride the bus with their child to and from the activity. NO ONE attending the field trip is permitted to purchase food, snacks, drinks, treats, gift shop items, extra add-ons, etc. This means items for yourself, your child, or other children.

Please note that LISD Summer Day Camp does not provide visitation time for non-custodial parents. We ask that you make visitation arrangements through the custodial parent or court personnel. Also, we cannot allow visitors, such as therapists, tutors, etc., to work with your child at LISD Summer Day Camp.

Members of the community are used to enrich the program in areas of art, dance, dramatics, social skills, crafts, and service. In addition, parents are welcome to participate as resource volunteers in any topic area where they would like to share their skills. Please contact our office for complete information about LISD's volunteer policies and procedures.

Medical Emergency

In case of a serious emergency, staff will call 911, then parents, and then the campus director (if not on campus). If the program director cannot be reached, call the Campus Support Services main office at 469-713-599 or 469-496-7815 (Fridays). The responding medical person will decide as to whether a child should be taken to a medical facility in the ambulance. Staff will take the child's contact information form and medical guardianship form and accompany the child. One aide will be designated to contact the parents and Campus Director (if not on Campus) to inform them of the situation and where the child is being transported.

Immunization Records Requirement

In compliance with the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), every child enrolled or admitted to our child-care center must have up-to-date immunization records. This requirement applies to every child in our care. If your child's immunization records are not already on file at an LISD elementary school, you will need to provide these records directly to the camp. Ensuring that all children are properly immunized is essential for maintaining a healthy and safe environment for everyone.

Students with Special Needs

We are committed to providing a safe and supportive environment for all children, including those with special care needs. Our approach includes understanding and respecting any limitations or restrictions on your child's activities. We offer reasonable accommodations and modifications if recommended by a healthcare professional. We prioritize open communication with parents to ensure that we are fully aligned in meeting your child's needs effectively and compassionately.

Health Checks

Our camp will conduct regular visual and physical assessments of each child to identify potential health concerns, including signs or symptoms of illness and injury. These assessments are especially important when there are noticeable changes in your child's behavior since their last date of attendance. Our goal is to ensure the well-being of every child by promptly addressing any health issues that may arise. If any concerns are identified, we will communicate with parents immediately to discuss the best course of action.

Policy Change Notifications

In the event of any changes to our policies, we will promptly notify parents via email using the email address we have on file. It is important to ensure that your contact information is current so that you receive these updates without delay. Our aim is to keep all parents informed and up-to-date on any important changes that may affect our child-care center.

Summer Day Camp Enrollment Process

To enroll, log into your Eleyo account or create a new account at <https://lisd.ce.eleyo.com/>. Registration opens first for current and waitlist ESD families, then to the public. Space is limited, so be sure to register early to secure your child's spot. We process registrations based on the submission timestamp. Once your registration is confirmed, we will send you a parent packet containing all the necessary paperwork for camp.

Student Code of Conduct SUMMER 2025

LISD SUMMER DAY CAMP/ JUNE 2nd THROUGH JULY 11th

The following is an excerpt from the LISD Student Code of Conduct. Participants in all LISD summer programs are expected to follow the policies published in the Code. A copy of the LISD Student Code of Conduct and Extracurricular Code of Conduct can be viewed in its entirety by requesting it from camp staff or online at www.lisd.net.

Parents – please discuss these policies with your children who will be attending LISD Summer Day Camp. Attached is an acknowledgment form for you and your child to sign and return to the staff.

Standards for Student Conduct - Behaviors

Each participant is required to:

- Be able to dress and tie shoes with little or no assistance
- Demonstrate courtesy and respect for others
- Behave in a responsible manner, always exercising self-discipline
- Obey program rules and campus rules

- Respect the rights and privileges of other students, teachers, and district staff
- Respect the property of others, including district property and facilities
- Participate in group activities
- Be able to function independently, including toilet procedures
- Cooperate fully with camp staff to maintain safety, order, and discipline

Camp staff may set rules in addition to those found in the Code to ensure the safety and well-being of participants. These will be posted at the camp location, and parents will receive notice of the new rules.

Consequences

The following discipline management techniques may be used – alone or in combination – for misbehavior violating the Student Code of Conduct or program rules:

- Verbal correction or reprimand
- Cooling-off time or time-out
- Time off from planned activities
- Temporary confiscation of items that disrupt the program
- Rewards or demerits
- Calls to parent or guardian to remove a child from the program
- Temporary removal from the program
- Permanent removal from the program
- Other consequences as defined by the LISD Student Code of Conduct

Any behavior that is disruptive to the daily operation of the program will be considered grounds for dismissal from the program with no refunds and no probationary period allowed.

Examples of such behavior include but are not limited to:

- Throwing objects that may cause bodily harm.
- Leaving school grounds or field trips without permission.
- Use of profanity toward participants or staff,
- Fighting.
- Stealing.
- Damaging LISD property or property of other participants.
- Disobeying camp rules on school buses.
- Threatening participants or camp staff.
- Engaging in or inciting violence.
- Engaging in inappropriate verbal conduct.
- Physical or sexual contact directed toward another participant, district employee, or camp staff member.
- Possessing weapons or pyrotechnic devices.
- Refusal to accept discipline management techniques assigned by camp staff.

Check In/ Out Policies SUMMER 2025

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Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures:

Summer Day Camp opens at 7 am and closes at 6 pm

Eleyo will be used for both drop-off and pick-up. Upon arrival, the parent or guardian will ring the doorbell and will be greeted by an SDC staff member and asked to sign in/out the student on the SDC iPad.

Students will be let into the building by a staff member or walked out by staff members to the parent or guardian. Parents and guardians will not be allowed in the building unless they are visiting, talking with a shift supervisor or director, or during parent night.

- Staff not recognizing an individual picking up a child will ask to see picture identification, i.e., Driver's License, etc. Only those individuals designated on the pickup list on Eleyo will be allowed to pick up.

- All ESD children must have alternate and emergency pick-up arrangements. Additional authorized pick-up people can be added in Eleyo, and campus staff will see it immediately. If a parent needs instructions, a form will be available to them upon request.
- A one-time emergency exception can be made by the enrolling parent/guardian by emailing the ESD staff and Zone Supervisor with their pick-up person's name, telephone number, and address.
 - That individual will need a picture ID to pick up the child.
- When the child is checked in/ out of SDC on the iPad, the pick-up person's name, signature, and time will be recorded on the child's timecard.

Because children's safety is our greatest concern, it is required that each parent must come to the SDC door each morning and evening to sign in/out their child.

Under no circumstances will camp staff allow any child to leave by themselves, with another child, or with an unauthorized adult.

Field Trips

- ✓ **PLEASE ARRIVE BEFORE DEPARTURE TIME.** We are on a tight schedule and will not wait for late arrivals. **If you are late, your child will miss the field trip, and you will have to make other childcare arrangements.** Please be on time.
- ✓ **Parents may not pick up or drop off children at field trip locations.** All transportation is by LISD Transportation and follows LISD regulations and safety procedures.
- ✓ Please check the weekly Camp Newsletter for up-to-date field trip schedule information. Texas summer weather is unpredictable and may cause our plans to change.

Late fees are in effect! Please be on time.

LISD Summer Day Camp uses the Eleyo attendance app for all official times. Summer Day Camp closes at 6:00 pm. A late charge of \$20 per child is assessed for the first 15 minutes (for example, 6:02 pm = \$20 per child). There is an additional \$20 charge for each additional 15 minutes or any portion thereof (for example, 6:18 pm = \$20 per child). Late pick-up charges will be collected with tuition the following week.

I understand and will abide by the LISD policy regarding late fees. If I am one (1) minute or more past 6:00 pm, I will be charged for that time according to the policy stated above.

Terms and Conditions:

1. I understand that my \$75 reservation fee per week is nonrefundable/nontransferable and is due once my registration is accepted.
2. I understand the remaining \$150 weekly balance will be invoiced at the time of registration and will be due by the payment due date.
3. I understand that if I need to cancel a reserved week, I will email SummerDayCamp@lisd.net no later than noon on the cancellation deadline. See the dates above.
4. I understand that I will not be refunded the \$150 remaining balance if I don't cancel by noon, according to the cancellation dates above.
5. I acknowledge that LISD is not responsible for declined payments. The payer on the account will receive an email of the payment decline and is responsible for making restitution within 24 hours or risk losing their space.
6. If you pay by ACH (e-check) or check and it declines once, a credit card or money order will be required for future payments.
7. I understand that once LISD Summer Day Camp begins, all refunds will be processed at the end of camp and are subject to a \$25 cancellation fee.
8. I understand that all participants will be held accountable for their behavior and will be subject to the disciplinary consequences outlined in the excerpted information.
9. I understand that LISD has the right to remove any child who does not follow the LISD Student Code of Conduct.
10. I also understand that, as a participant in a paid program offered by the LISD Campus Support Services department, if I am asked to leave the program due to my child's behavior, I will forfeit any remaining days in the program and will not be refunded any payments for this program.

The Rainforest section features a zero-depth entry pool, two platform levels with a bridge, water cannons, bubblers, spray bars, water slides, a 200-foot lazy river, and a 600-gallon dump bucket. The Main Pool section consists of a 50-meter Olympic-sized pool with a 25-meter short course, a training pool, a separate diving well, and a 22-foot structure with a two-flume slide.

Safety is our top priority. We have a 1:10 staff-to-student ratio on all pool field trips.

We are currently exploring options for a new pool location for our Flower Mound campuses (Bluebonnet and Wellington). While we do not have a confirmed site at this time, we are actively working to secure a location that will provide a fun and safe swimming experience for our campers. We will share updates as soon as more information becomes available.

Wristbands

RED wristbands are for students who are SHALLOW ONLY. These students will only be allowed to swim in areas that are 3 feet 6 inches or less.



Students without a wristband are allowed to swim in all areas of the pool, including the diving boards.

For identification purposes, all students on the field trip will also receive a **BLUE**, **DARK GREEN**, **ORANGE**, or **PURPLE** wristband to show which Summer Day Camp they attend. These colored wristbands have the LISD Summer Day Camp name and phone number.

Sunscreen

At the beginning of camp, we will collect sunscreen from each student. **We recommend Coppertone Continuous Sunscreen Spray, Sport SPF 50.**

The sunscreen will be placed in a communal bucket and used to apply 2nd sunscreen for all campers at the pool. **All students will be given a second sunscreen at the pool.**

If your child is sensitive to certain sunscreens, please notify the staff. Accommodations can be made.

All students should arrive ready for the pool with sunscreen applied and wearing their swimsuits.
