

Greater Draconic Power

Prerequisites: Dragonborn, Kobold, or Half-Dragon

Your draconic heritage is magically pronounced, and your claws, teeth, or other features also becomes more pronounced.

- At the start of your turn, if your breath weapon or draconic roar has been used, roll a d6. On a 6, you regain a use of your breath weapon or draconic roar. You can use this trait to regain a use of your breath weapon or draconic roar a number of times equal to your proficiency bonus. You regain all expended uses of this ability once you finish a short or long rest.
- If you have a breath weapon, it deals an additional amount of damage equal to your Constitution modifier. If you have a draconic roar, it also gives any enemies within the area disadvantage on attack rolls against you and your allies.
- You gain a natural weapon that deals damage equal to 1d6 plus your Strength or Dexterity modifier. The damage type depends on the feature that was enhanced (piercing for your teeth and a bite attack, slashing for your claws and a claw attack, etc).
