- ★ Infinite Campus accounts for families: WCPSS will be launching Infinite Campus, the new Student Information System adopted by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction, for the 2025-26 school year. Infinite Campus will replace PowerSchool and be used districtwide to house student data including

grades, schedules, bus stop information. Families received an email from Infinite Campus (sis-notifications@wcpss.net) to the parent/guardian email address on file for their student with instructions to access their portals. Contact your school's data manager to ensure your contact information is up-to-date.

- ★ Bus Transportation 2025-2026 School Year: The deadline for guaranteed first-day service for year-round calendar students has passed. If you are not currently assigned to transportation but would like service next school year, you must request transportation. Once transportation has been assigned, you will be notified with your transportation start date. Please only request service if you plan for your student to be a regular rider. Students who don't ride consistently will be removed from bus rosters. To register, go to www.wcpss.net/busrider-Bus Assignments and Eligibility. Yellow bus assignments are determined by student eligibility. If you have any questions concerning eligibility status, please contact Transportation Customer service at 919-805-3030.
