Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.

2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

4. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.

6. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.

7. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

<b>Ozzie</b>	Royal Creek	Div. App.	Retired show horse. Babysitter; great draw. Cluck to trot, kiss to lope. Works off of leg pressure to pivot – division appropriate spurs if needed. Very easy to ride. Walk/trot deluxe.
<b>Prada</b>	DMB	Ball Spur	Ball Spur Option, 2 hand option, straight forward draw, soft rein contact, keep encouraging forward through all gates, rides like a ranch horse.
<b><u>Riot</u></b>	SL	No Spur	2 hand option for the ranch and reining, 1 hand for the horsemanship. Contact with face, can bridle up, don't override. He will react to your body and be busy if you are. No Spur
<b>Rosie</b>	Royal Creek	Ball Spurs	Sorrel mare. Great draw; retired show horse. Walk/trot deluxe. Ball spurs if needed. Not tight rein and don't gouge with the spur. Sweet mare.

<b>Smarty</b>	TMC	No Spurs	2 hand option, if you get quick she will get quick. set up for leads, don't sit forward. Ride leg to hand. Keep on the rail. No Spurs
<b>Sweet</b>	Cornerhouse	No Spurs	No spurs. Two hand option. Have contact. Listens to vocals. Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Watch leads. She will jog and lope but will build speed if rider allows her.
<b>T</b>	Southern Ohio	Div. App.	Palomino QH Gelding. Ranch type. Responds best to voice commands. Hum and sit deep and release legs to slow a Lots of leg pressure to speed up (can be lazy). Cluck and kick for jog/trot. Kiss and cue for lope. Say Whoa, sit deep and release legs to stop. Less likely to break in extended trot if you post vs stand. Prefers a looser rein, but can be taken in for horsemanship patterns. Spurs according to division. Two-hand option may be preferred for ranch and reining or patterns with circles.
<b>Tex</b>	Royal Creek	Ball Spurs	Simple draw. Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Use leg and rein to pivot. Hold light pressure in hand during extended jog. Ball Spurs
<b>Tiger</b>	Concord	No Spurs	Big guy, super sweet! 2 hand option. Easy No Spurs
<b>Timmy</b>	SL	Div. App.	A reining gelding (does not have plates on right now) two hand option, can ride into his face, set up for left lead and keep outside legs on or he we change leads. Division appropriate spur. Use voice. Good boy.
<b>Tommy</b>	TMC	No Spurs	Great draw, don't over collect. Set up for right lead. Barn favorite No Spurs
<b>Zip</b>	Puthoff	Div. App.	Very lazy. Rough canter, go forward. Can do ranch also. But very lazy for lead change. Crop option for walk trot. Be sure to set him up for right lead. Spur appropriate for all other divisions.

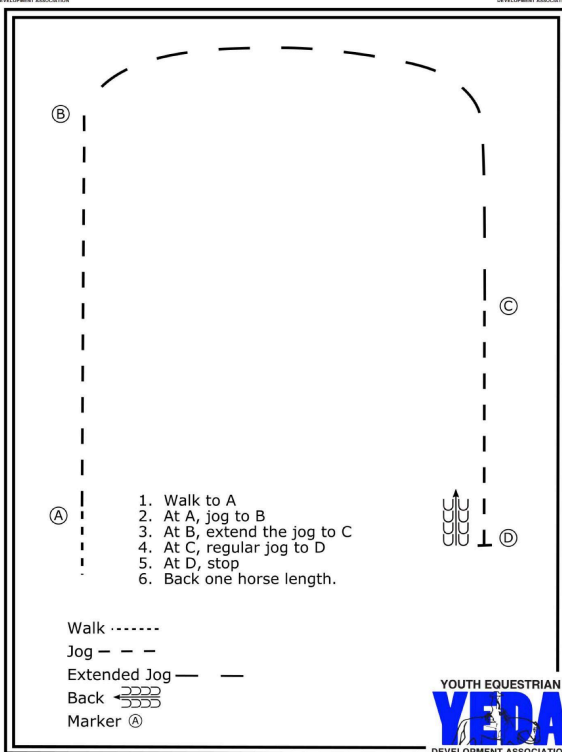

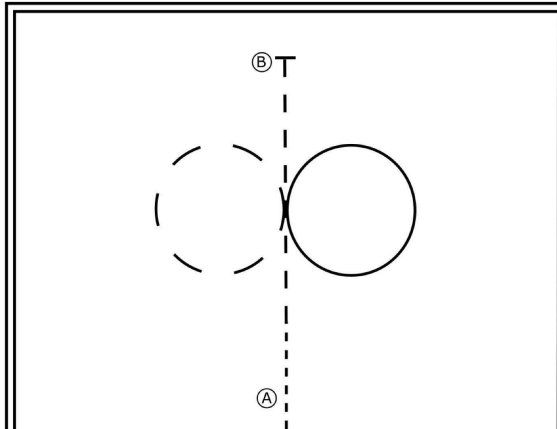
## Ruby Pattern 4

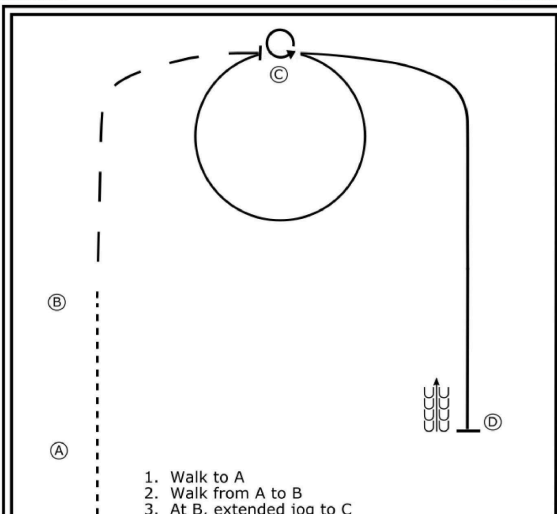

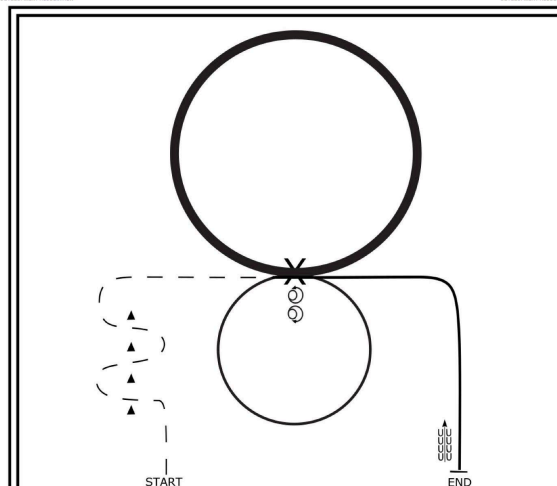
## Diamond Pattern 4

7. Stop at D and back one horse length.

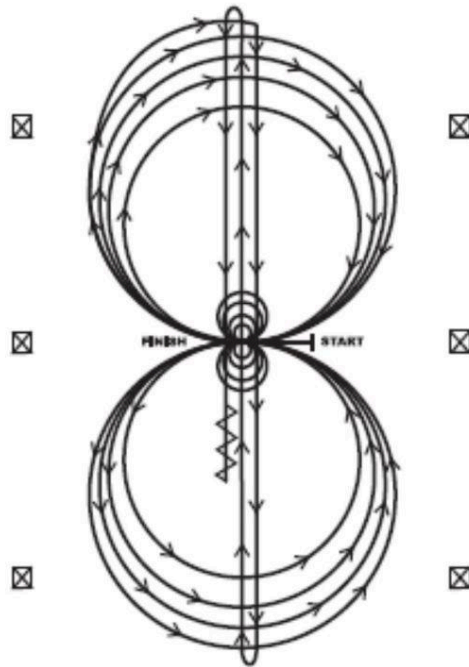

## Ranch Riding Pattern 4



1. Trot through serpentine
2. Lope a large fast circle to the left on the left lead
3. Change leads
4. Lope a small slow circle to the right, stop
5. 2 spins left, 2 spins right
6. Lope on the right lead and turn right
7. Stop and back 5 steps.

# NRHA Pattern 4



Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1.Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.

2.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.

4.Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.

5.Beginning on the right lead, run a large fast circle to the right, change leads at the center of the arena, run large fast circle to the left, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)

6.Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

7.Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.

8.Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

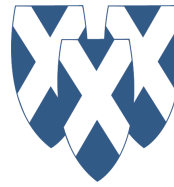
